


New Testament

When I was a young man, the apostle Paul took over my spiritual training.





Read or quote 2 Timothy 1:5.






When you ask for my help, I'll teach you more about how to talk to Jesus, so you can grow to love Jesus more.

ways to grow closer to Him!




The Bible talks about how bold John and I were (Acts 4:13). We weren't bold in ourselves, but it was a gift Jesus gave us for witnessing to people.

Peter wrote two letters that are found in the New Testament,  $1^{\rm st}$  and  $2^{\rm nd}$  Peter.











Now, thanks to Jesus and His Word, I am full of faith! I have absolute faith that Jesus is going to work all things out for good, even when things seem to be going wrong.




I love watching the Family on Earth.

Read John 20:19-29.






I want to help you find the true happiness that comes from spending time with Jesus and with those who love Jesus. Whenever you need help to get to know someone better, ask me for help.
