

WHAT TO DO FROM 2 TIMOTHY 2!--Timothy was a Teenager too!

The Apostle Paul wrote two books in the Bible to "Timothy, my own son in the faith" (1 Tim.1:2), who "from a child has known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto Salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus!" (2 Tim.3:15) Several times Paul gives Timothy a charge--like a responsibility or command--or a Teen Challenge, of what Timothy should do & strive to be for the Lord! "This charge I commit unto thee, Son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou mightest war a good warfare!"

Take a look at these key charges or commands that Paul gave Timothy the Teen in 2 Timothy 2, following along in your own Bible, being sure to apply them to your own life as an Endtime Teen Soldier, Revolutionary & Fighter for the Faith!

- v.1--Be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.
- v.2--Teach others, (faithful men!) who shall be able to teach others to teach others too!
- v.3--Endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ!
- v.4--Be not entangled (See Gal.5:1) with affairs of this life, so you can war for the Lord!
--Please Him Who hath chosen you to be a soldier! (See Jn.15:16)
- v.7--Consider the Godly counsel given you--The Lord will give you understanding in all things!
- v.8--Remember what Jesus has done to save

you!

- v.9--Though you may suffer, as Paul did, even in bonds, the Word of God is not bound!
- v.10--Endure all things (See 1 Cor.13:7), especially for the help & salvation of others.
- v.11--Die daily to yourself to live for Jesus! (See Luke 9:23,24)
- v.12--If you suffer, you shall also reign with Jesus! If you deny Him, He also will deny you!
- v.13--God is always faithful & will never be unfaithful to us!
- v.14--Remember this counsel, to charge & teach & admonish others!
- v.15--Study the Word of Truth to show yourself approved unto God! Be a workman who will not be ashamed, but bold!
- v.16--Shun profane & vain babblings!--(Avoid evil or foolish, vain babble) which will increase unto more ungodliness! (Watch your words!)
- v.22--Flee also youthful lusts! ("Put away childish things."--1 Cor.13:11)
--Follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- v.23--Avoid foolish & unlearned questions, knowing that they cause strife, or disagreement & trouble.
- v.24--Be gentle unto all men, able to teach, patient.
- v.25--In meekness, leading those who don't believe.
