Yesterday was one of the very, very greatest blessings of my life, and I'm eternally grateful to the Lord for the opportunity to meet and be with you. It seemed as if the time passed by so quickly, almost

like a dream you remember as you wake, and yet the evening so impressed me that it's as if the dream still lingers on in reality. You are such a tremendous inspiration to me and to so many, and all I can say is, God bless you both and help me to spread that same spirit of love to everyone I meet.

What impressed me most was (is) the Spirit of love that you carry. I told Maria that I was so nervous just prior to meeting you, as I had always gotten nervous around Deb and Jeth, and yet you both made me feel so at peace and so calm, just to be in your presence, that I could hardly believe it. It was such a spirit of trust, love and confidence—no cover-ups, false-fronts, no show—just the true, sincere and honest love of Jesus shining through you, not just towards me, but towards everyone with whom you came in contact: waiters, fish, door-men. You both took so much of yours and God's precious time to show them love and concern.

I had been around Deb and Jeth when they were trying to impress me or convince me that they loved me and to win my confidence in them. But they would be sour with others: waiters, other brethren, or some little sheep that fell across our path. I always felt bad, as if the love was a little less than sincere and genuine, and it therefore seldom fully won my confidence. But last night, you both were so natural, so real, so concerned, so loving with everyone, that I knew and believed that it was the real, true love of Jesus!

What equally impressed me was

your true concern for the sheep. When you asked me, "Lovest thou me?", I felt like a simple little fisherman being instructed by Jesus on the shores of Galilee (and it was Jesus in you asking me). Your every concern seemed to be the sheep—those beside you, those around you—your sheep and children everywhere. It so impressed me! I answered "yes", and my only hope and prayer is to live up to the calling of a true shepherd, to lay down his life for the sheep.

Maria impressed me with her openness and sincerity, and her simple manner really inspired my confidence. A little bit of love really goes a long way, so I guess a lot of love goes even further. The love and faith you both showed is carrying us to the ends of the Earth with God's message of Love! God bless you!

I could see or rather feel how Arthur and so many others had flipped head over heels for Maria, as she makes you feel so calm, like a little child rocking in its mother's arms. God bless you, Maria, I love you and thank God for the time I was able to spend with you, as it made me feel so much closer to you, my Family and most of all, to the Lord.

Also, Venezuela is a real open door for reaching the "founding fathers" of other countries who pass through there, and may be the most important place in Latin America! The people we can reach there can help us to reach whole countries, if we would just reach them first. God help us! So your sample last night to us is going to help us to reach Latin America!

Yet it is sooo true! PTL!

It was just great to see the love you all expressed for each other and the real concern for other people, which requires a teamwork of a kind that I hadn't really seen practised before in this way. It blew my mind how little we did, but how much God arranged things and how much He did and what a result it already had in the fruit of one night.

Being so open about FF'ing never entered my mind. I had not been able to see how we would witness to people that know "all" (ha!) about us. So last night I saw what it is like to give God all the glory and be open about it, which now I can see better also in a situation where you would not be able to use the organisation name, but still be open about it.

I have to confess, before I met you, I was a little scared of what it would be like. Lord help me, but it's true! So then when I got to meet you, you imparted such calm-

ness and love that I felt so much more relaxed right away. I do want to apologise that I was still a little nervous throughout the evening, but it is so new for me to be with people who are able to look right into your soul. I am just beginning to learn to be the way I am and see that we are all the same and God made us the way we are and loves us even in spite of our shortcomings, so we don't need to pretend.

All evening I had to keep thinking about something you said in "Revolutionary Women", how so many people love you, because you have so much love. How true!! If I hadn't been in love with you already, it would have been "love at first sight" for sure! Now my love for you is deeper than ever! I wish so much that I could stay near you for awhile, because your sample helps me so much, because I need you so very, very much and only hope that this is not really selfish. If there is one thing I have seen while I have been here, it is that I need God's love and strength as well as your help to do anything, and that He, on the other hand, can do everything with us, that it is not us, but His Mercy. What a relief!

It gave me so much more faith and hope that I can at least get something done for Him!! If I have only come to the king's house to learn that, it was certainly worth it, and I feel so very thankful for this and count it a real, real blessing and wish even more to stay. May God help me to never forget this though, wherever I am and whatever I do!!
