New Indigenous FF Team— EXPLODES!

I have so much to share with you about our new FF explosion here! It all began with your inspiration and burden to see these precious nationals used and also for the sake of the wonderful men we have met in pioneering FF'ing, too. We are all so inspired and raring to go!!—and have some testimonies to share with you about recent FF adventures!

First of all, I had the opportunity to interview these girls to see if they wanted to live in an FF Home, and they were all so ready and full of ideas right from the beginning, that we couldn't wait to get started! The girls are two who were in Tenerife, and two other new ones, both 22 years old. Next we will have Sara, a very potential girl leader, and Maria from Lima, both move to the new FF apartment in town.

All these girls like men very much and have done some FF'ing before, but never to the extent that they have wanted to. I have been amazed at how well they do with these big important business men—because they love the Lord, they love men and they love you and the Words!

It has been so inspiring to me, the "fisherwoman" to see these girls make a new beginning since the "RNR" and are making their own decisions, so that in only several nights going out together, the girls have made more progress in their FF'ing than some of us did in

weeks and weeks going with a fisherman!

We are able to discuss the very next day what happened the night before, and because they all live together (or will soon all six be together), they can fellowship and discuss things at home with no difficulty. So, right from the beginning they have learned how to pioneer a new fishing hole, make good relations with the management where we go, how to meet men at a bar or club, and all the etiquette it can involve.

It is very convenient for two lil' teams of two girls each to go to a high-class bar hotel, sit down for a drink and eventually and casually begin talking either to the men closest to you or "make eyes" at the ones you hope to come over. We have found that it is not accepted bar etiquette here to change seats and go to men we know or even to sit with them at a table on invitation—that is, until we are better known in a place and the management understand that we are not soliciting men (at least not for money, ha!). The girls have learned to be sweet to the waiters, to tip and become accepted first, which is very, very important for this type of work! There are plenty of professionals in these hotels, and they are there by license with the business, so we don't want to cause obvious trouble!—But rather, get to know a few men and the waiters so they can "cover" for us

and like the idea that we are there on a friendly basis.

Usually, the men come in by twos, usually an employee entertaining a visiting boss or client in the hotel. Before or just after dinner, they come in to the hotel bar for a drink. They pay for the drink that we first order. If it's a drink that lasts a long time, that is all we have, unless we go on to the hotel club for the evening together!

We have not paid anything at all, and have met some very nice and important, receptive men at these bars thus far, including owners of corporations, bankers, lawyers, and sub-director of a large newspaper.

One night a man who had not even talked with us paid for our drinks—just because he liked us and our smiles! GBH! Because these men are usually travelling through, we do not see the same ones too often, and so we take turns going to three places during the week. Also, we have not had to go home with them in the car because they are staying in the hotel. So, even if just one of the girls goes upstairs, the other one can wait for her with her date in the hotel club. The men have even offered to pay our taxi fare home! FF'ing really pays, Dad!

One of the most inspiring things of all, to me, is what a vision the girls have for financing their own FF Home! They have only a very small three-bedroom home and are living with a real sweet couple with a two-year-old child. The apartment itself is not very nice, but when I visited there yesterday, we all got to work cleaning and scrubbing away

and making it more "homey", adding that special woman's touch! Thank the Lord the brother there is a "fix-it" man and has made plans to make more hanging space, etc.

The girls go litnessing in the afternoon and FF'ing almost every night, as long as two people are home with the child. Just before I left there, a friendly fish came to visit them (who knew some of the girls before) and donated all new furniture for their apartment! He will deliver a few chair-type beds that fold out, also a sofa that folds out to a double bed, full-length mirrors for the doors, closets, rugs, shelves and wall mirrors! The girls were so happy and had been faithfully praying and obeying, so the Lord has already rewarded them, PTL!

The apartment won't seem so crowded now with these fold-up beds, and the living room can be used for a love room in emergencies!! We have already begun to plan and pray how to provision FF clothes and material, because two of the girls can sew, and also to patronise a good boutique store where we can ask for a discount, or maybe send the brother there with us, to FF the sales girls! Ha! Love never fails, and it sure is a beautiful life to live! Hallelujah!

It's still in the pioneer stages, but what brave pioneers they are! Their evening bags come complete with ID cards, funds, door keys, vaseline and MO Letters in special little envelopes for "personal" gifts! Pray for us! We've got all of this city to love for Jesus, and we love you! —Your Sara.
