Give us the wisdom, Lord, to be patient, give us the wisdom to just have <u>love</u> and depend by faith upon <u>Thy</u> power to

do the job by <u>Thy Spirit</u>. It is our job to witness, to bring the truth and to love. Help us Lord, in Jesus' Name, to do it in such a way that w do not offend and draw enmity of the System and make them feel threatened or harmed, which is not wisdom." (542:118-20)

So anyway, God help us if we're overstating the case, but we person-ally have seen these quotes really come alive so much more since spending time in these fields, and we just wanted to share them with the vision of what we see coming to pass through them. God help us if we're through them. God help us if we're wrong. If so, the whole work out here is way off the beam because it's really the way the vast majority if not the entire Family out here sees it.

SUNGLASSES

Whenever you're out in bright summer sunlight, you should wear sunglasses, especially if your eyes are green or blue and thus lack protective pigment. Lenses should be of high-quality, nondistorting glass or plastic. Plastic lenses won't break but they scratch more easily and should be cleaned with a wet cloth. Grey, green and amber lenses distort color perception the least, while blue and pink lenses cannot be recommended. Polosied lenses be recommended. Polarised lenses, which cut down on reflected light: are good for fishing, sailing or pool

HEPATITIS

Infectious hepatitis, characterised by inflammation of the liver, severe fatigue, nausea, fever and jaundice, is very contagious via stool, urine, saliva, blood, semen or vaginal discharge. To catch it, you would have to absorb the virus directly through the mucous membranes of mouth, vagina or rectum, or through a cut or puncture in the skin. You can't catch infectious hepatitis merely by being around someone who has it being around someone who has it unless you kiss him or have sexual intercourse or use the same eating utensils. The best precautions are:

(1) Don't share food; (2) disinfect all eating utensils with boiling water;
(3) avoid physical contact such as kissing and intercourse. Sent in by Maria & Sara.
