Care & Cleanliness of Baby Bottles!

A must for all new mothers! by SARA DAVIDITO

TO STERILISE OR NOT TO STERILISE? This is a rather controversial subject. Some modern baby books de-emphasise it. But with so many of our new moms liv ing under difficult conditions such as in Third World countries or on the road or just setting up house etc., sterilising is needed, I believe.

For the first 3 months at least, -For the first 3 months at least, and up to 6 months or more if travelling or in Third World countries. Better safe than sorry!

STEPS TO CLEANLINESS
BOTTLES & NIPPLES WITH THE MEREST TRACE OF MILK left on them are liable to breed earns from

them are liable to breed germs from bacteria in the milk and are harder to sterilise. This means that cleaning the bottle & nipple immediately after each use is a must!

1. RINSE BOTTLE & NIPPLE in

cold water to remove any leftover milk. Hot water makes the milk stick. (If you're unable to thoroughly wash the bottle immediately, be sure to at least follow this step.)

2. WASH YOUR HANDS & NAILS thoroughly with hot water & soap.
3. RUB THE NIPPLES WITH

TABLE SALT, inside & out. This is to remove the milk slime that always clings to the rubber even after rinsing.

4. WASH BOTTLE well with

clean, hot water & dish detergent, using a bottle brush.

5. WASH NIPPLE in the same way with a nipple brush. You can make sure the hole is not blocked by putting your thumb over the opening & squeezing the water thru'.

6. RINSE BOTTLE & NIPPLE

well with hot or warm clear, clean water.

7. DRAIN DRY, Avoid using tow els as they can harbour germs if not kept very clean.—Or put nipples & bottles immediately into sterilising vessel & sterilise.
