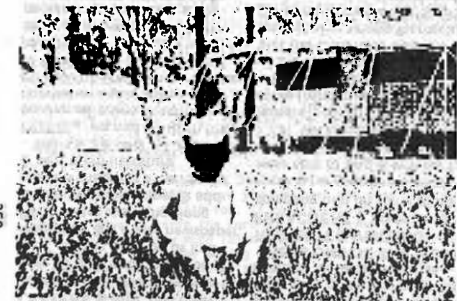
TO SAY that the Camping Letters are so needed & reliable. Every little thing Mo says is so true—as we found out thru' experience! Hal

WE FOUND THAT A SMALL "PUP TENT" IS NOT ADEQUATE for a couple & baby for any length of time. We experienced 2 near floods & the baby teething in the middle of it! The Lord raised up friends to take us in & according to Phil. 4:19 He supplied the funds to buy a miraculously cheap station wagon which was being sold in a caravan park.

WE FOUND CARAVAN PARKS TO BE GOOD PLACES TO BUY CHEAP EQUIPMENT, tents & vans as people advertise on the notice board. We found the car indispensable as we slept, travelled & nearly lived in it. When we bothered to put up the tent, it was mainly for storage or an FF love room!

IF WE HAD THE MONEY, we usually found caravan parks to be worth \$2 or \$3 per night for a tent site, laundry & bathroom facilities & often a swimming pool to teach baby Jo to swim. Also caravan parks are sooooo good for witnessing! The people are all around you, so you have a ready-made field right there. There are usually lots of children to "Open the Door" to. A lot of kids got saved & I showed flannelgraphs etc. to the kids who gathered 'round. I was also able to FF 2 campers. One was a lonely widower who was so grateful. It really changed his life.

ONE PROBLEM WE HAD WAS LACK OF FELLOWSHIP & poor communications with our mail. It might be good to

Tips on Buying Used Vehicles in Europe

From Elkanah; S. Europe: **WE WANTED TO SHARE HOW THE LORD ENABLED US TO GET MOBILE.** In our case it has really been "Use It", more specifically the Metro System of a large European city. In a 20-day concerted effort of singing carriage-to-carriage, 3 of us were able to set aside about \$3,000 towards a van & caravan! I'm not going to say it was easy, because it wasn't! I think the hardest part was the constant noise & vibration of the trains, but God gave us the grace for it, because we had a definite goal to reach! PTL!

ANOTHER MIRACLE THEN HAPPENED only hours before I was to leave for Amsterdam to look for a vehicle. I met up with Arthur, Becky, Zaccheus & Lamb who had just come from buying a van & caravan in Holland. They gave me the name & address of their contact, a good friend, & within 4 hours of arriving in Amsterdam I had bought a 1972 Mercedes 608 van, 17 feet long & a very nice 13-foot caravan, TYJ!

ANOTHER PLACE TO FIND INEXPENSIVE VEHICLES is outside the American Express in both Amsterdam & Paris. Another place is the "car auction", not really an auction, in Utrecht, Holland.

IT MAY BE BEST TO GET A DIESEL ENGINE rather than one that uses regular petrol as diesel fuel is much cheaper in many countries.

A PLACE TO FIND INEXPENSIVE CARAVANS is the Isle of Sheppy, 70 miles east of London. It's an island connected by a bridge to the mainland, & there are 72 caravan sights there. You might have to be careful because they are older caravans & are also pretty heavy. You may have to paint it, put your own lights on it, tires & reinforce the tongue. We just went there, told people we were missionaries & asked around. I bought a 16-footer for only \$100 there in 1975, towed it all the way to Tunisia & sold it 3 years later for more than I paid for it! I hope these tips are a blessing in giving you some ideas on how to get mobile! Love, Elkanah.

Favourite One-Pot Meals!

From Mother Eve:

CHOP SUEY (Serves 4)

Cut into small pieces:

2 cups cooked meat such as chick-

en, beef or even canned tuna! ½ a small green cabbage 2 large onions ½ the leafy part of a large celery Cook in a large frying pan: All the vegetables in 2 Tablespoons oil. Add up to ¼ cup water if necessary. When the vegetables are nice & tender but not soggy, add 2 Tablespoons soy sauce & the meat. Note: Canned or fresh beans cut small &/or canned or fresh Chinese bamboo shoots can be substituted.

From Taberah; South America: **SPAGHETTI BOLOGNESE**, one-pot style! (Serves 6) Cook together until done: 1 onion, diced 1 teaspoon oregano 1 clove garlic, split 3/4 kg. hamburger In the same pot, add: Just enough water to cook 400 gr. noodles. When the water boils, add the noodles along with a small can tomato paste. When it's all done, add salt to taste. Good with a fresh salad & red wine!

AFTER EXPLORATORY SURGERY, the head surgeon, whom I had witnessed to often the year before, sat beside me on the bed & told me: "God does heal miraculously sometimes, but not always." He said they had found tissue cancer! Well, PTL, I never doubted! Faith is knowing! I left it in God's hands.

MEANWHILE MY TWO CHILDREN—Job-5 & Daniella-2— visited the hospital with over 50 love buttons that every nurse, technician, doctor, cleaning lady etc. on my floor received! Soon other nurses & technicians from different floors came to my room & asked if I was the lady handing out "love"! I smiled & said, "You came to the right door!"

WE ALSO WENT DOOR-TO-DOOR ON THE ENTIRE

And find our transplanted bloom.

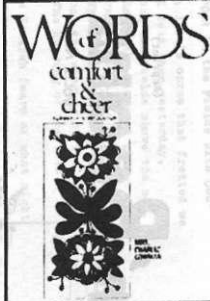
"He shall gather the lambs with His Arm and carry them in His bosom." (Isa. 40:11.)
