### Our New Field-A Dream Come True!

Miraculous open doors in first month to start a far-reaching music outreach!

PG & GIJN FROM THESE FAR-FLUNG ISLANDS where God has done in one month exceeding & abundantly above all that we asked or thought & has been fulfilling promise after promise & dream after dream! A year ago when we were in Holland & praying for God's will, the Lord gave me 4 dreams indicating we were to go to these islands which had been my boyhood home from ages 11-17! Two of the dreams even indicated the name of the town where we were to go, which is where we are now, PTL! At the time of the dreams, it had been sufficiently staffed but just before we arrived it was vacated, just one of the little miracles God has done for us, PHN!

IN JULY AFTER 6 MONTHS OF PLANNING TO GO, even my getting a job to save money, we still had almost no funds saved. Beginning to wonder if the Lord even wanted us to go, Zion prayed for Him to supply the funds if it was His will, & within a half-hour a precious Family couple walked in & said the Lord had told them to give us the fare from an inheritance he had received, PGI! God is still on the throne & prayer changes things!

MANY OTHER WONDERFUL FAMILY MEMBERS, FRIENDS, RELATIVES & even the Dutch social service helped in innum-

erable ways so that on Jan. 9th, together with Jeriah Harper who had joined us when we answered his want ad, we & our 4 children were ready to go.

IT WAS A BIT SCAREY because we had no phone number, address or anything of any Homes in the Philippines. (Thru a mail mixup we had never received the VS's letters to us.) But we just knew the Lord would take care of us, & He did! It was a beautiful sight to see

our new VS's smiling face awaiting us at the airport. We stayed at their Home for that first week until...

WE WERE READY TO HIT THE ROAD with our newly acquired van, the tent we'd brought from Holland, & a new addition to our team, Bert, a native new disciple who came with us & has been a great blessing.

THE FIRST WEEK & A HALF WE CAMPED OUT & just like Dad said, it's a wonderful life, & we plan to travel & do more of it. But unbeknownst to us, the Lord was moving at breakneck speed to bring us in to favour & contact with the upper echelon of local & national society!

AS A RESULT, WE ARE

NOW LIVING IN A VERITABLE MANSION in the country for a rent of about \$25 a mo. It has its own well with electric & hand pumps, mango, banana, papaya & kalamansi trees, & is surrounded by friendly farmers. The owner is a top official in the government in its youth program. At the time we spoke to him about our work & the possibility of staying in his house, our baby Marie was sick & coughing very badly. Later he said it was compassion for her more than anything that prompted him to let us stay.

WE TOLD HIM IN PARTING THAT WE WOULD BE PRAYING FOR HIM & the very next day he was given a big promotion by the President! He said he knew it happened because we have been praying for him. Consequently he has received us as members of his family & wants to take us on his travels with him to set up youth clubs for drama & music, giving us complete freedom to preach & proclaim our message!

ONE OF THE THINGS THAT IMPRESSED HIM THE MOST was our gathering of the poor neighbourhood children 3 times a week for an "Open the Door for the Children". So far, 41 children have gotten saved thereby & we have won the love, respect & favour of the entire neighbourhood thru' it. And more kids are coming all the time, parents too!

SOME OF US WERE ABLE TO PERFORM ON RADIO too—Jeriah, a sister named Maureen, Joella, our 7-year-old, & I—reaching at least 4 million people in 2 different broadcasts. We did a skit, sang songs & I gave my testimony. It was so well received that we are now very seriously considering starting our own MWM show here.

THE OTHER MAJOR THING THE LORD IS DOING (& I'd

like to emphasise that it's all the Lord because we have done nothing more than we have done in other places, yet we've never seen so much action in one mo. time!) began at a town fiesta where we sang twice for 3-4 thousand people each time. The first time it was Jeriah, Maureen, Joella & myself; the next time Zion & 2-year-old Michael joined us along with 10 of our "Open the Door" children who rendered spirited versions of "I'm in Love With Jesus" with motion pictures & "You Gotta Be a Baby".

THRU' THESE PERFORMANCES we've met the entire upper crust of our community & the Mayor has taken a personal heart-to-heart interest in us & our work & has spent hours talking to us about it, telling us to come by anytime if we need anything.

DOORS ARE OPENING ON EVERY SIDE! We don't know where it's going to lead or end,

but we're just riding this great wave in total awe of God's wonder-working power & His mercy in pulling us out of the West just in time & putting us in the most beautiful, friendly, open, receptive & responsive field any of us have ever seen! TYL & thank you Dad that your words kept us going all these years so this dream could come true!

OF COURSE WE'VE HAD LOTS OF BATTLES & TRIALS especially with sickness among the kids as they adapt as well as us grown-ups learning to mold together as a united team; yet at the same time the miracles & contacts have been steadily flowing down—& in such a way as to know it's God & that we could never doubt, fear or turn back! Hallelujah! Please keep us & our ministry in your prayers! Love, Habakkuk, Zion & team.
