Toilet Training in Southeast Asia

SINCE COMING TO ASIA
FROM A USTRALIA we have
learned many little tips & money
savers which we'd like to share
with our worldwide Family.
The most valuable thing we've
learned is in toilet training babies. When our son Micah was
5½ months old we went from
Malaysia to Indonesia.
WE STARTED OUT BY
RENTING A ROOM in the
house of a Chinese family. During that time Micah had a very
bad diaper rash which wouldn't
go away, tho' I changed him as
often as he wet & tried to air it
out etc.

OUR LANDLADY SHOWED ME HOW SHE TOILET TRAIN-ED HER SON by just putting pants on him. The way they do it is just pull the inside leg of

pants on him. The way they do it is just pull the inside leg of their pants over so their penie is sticking out while holding them under the knees in a sitting position up level with your turnmy. Then they go "pshsh pshsh" until they do their wee.

I WAS PRETTY SKEPTICAL AT FIRST, but it worked & his heat/diaper rash disappeared. In these hot countries it's pretty cruel to keep a baby in diapers & plastic pants. We just held him over the toilet, or when we were out over the grass or down a drain, & made a noise "pshsh pshsh". We did it about every 15-20 minutes & when he awoke from a nap. Usually he did it, but if he wriggled & complained, we'd just let him down & try later.

OF COURSE SOMETIMES

OF COURSE, SOMETIMES WE FORGOT & HE WET HIS

PANTS, but it's no problem to mop up a little puddle on the concrete floors they have here. Now he's a year old & wees less frequently, so just wear 1 pair of pants all day usually. The Lord gives us checks just at the time he needs to "go". It sure is a blessing while travelling or out litnessing not to have to carry around a bunch of diapers, & disposable ones cost a fortune here.

because he was very irregular & messed up all the sheets on our bed regularly. But at 8 months old we bought him a potty & sat him on it every morning. The Chinese toilet train their children at 6 months like this (very smart people) & told me banana helps them to be regular. So Micah's been doing his doo doo's in the pot ever since.
