These accidents broke me enough that I decided to look somewhere else for the road to the happiness I longed so much to find.

IN REALITY I WAS SEEKING MY OWN HAPPINESS & my own personal satisfaction & was day by day forgetting my

"WE'D LIKE TO KNOW WHAT DAD FEFLS IS A GOOD LITNESSING QUOTA for families with children. We got out 700 per adult this month. Dad in the past suggested 1000 per adult, but there were many more single brethren then. Same with souls won. We know we're not under a law, but we'd like to have some fatherly counsel."-Amaziah & Kezia; U.S.A. (About 25 a day in USA per adult may not be too bad now their hearts are harder & more resistant, & you've also got the kids to care for. But some used to do 25 an hour with kids for good donations! - D.)

"OUR OLDEST GIRL, AGE 8, is having problems with system school. She really hates it & wants just to litness & serve God!"-James & Jacinth Psalms. (Hallelujah!-A real revolutionary!-Dad.)

We have found that altho' the Mountain House Dehydrated Food is good quality, that the Rainy Day Foods produced & distributed by the Mormons have proved to be about 1/5 the price. Altho' this unit has no meat, it does have other protein sources, but must be coupled with powdered milk, honey, wheat, lentils &/or other beans.
