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SAMOA

1. MINISTRIES POSSIBLE: As for New Caledonia.
2. FAMILY NEEDED? No one there at the moment.
3. VISAS: Altho' it's not official, in fact Americans can stay in American Samoa indefinitely. Western Samoa is much more primitive.
4. HEALTH: Ok.
5. USEFUL INFO: Much smaller than most of the other islands, so outreach is limited accordingly. Fairly poor in comparison, & there isn't a big tourist trade. Perhaps better for passing thru' & witnessing & getting addresses rather than setting up a permanent work. Whatever the Lord leads, tho'. PTL!

SOLOMON ISLANDS

1. MINISTRIES POSSIBLE: Only a drop-in approach is feasible because of visas.
2. FAMILY NEEDED? We have a team of 5 there now.
3. VISAS: Visitors' Permits are issued only on arrival & are only valid for 2 months here so it would be a real help to bring lots with you. Even camping equipment, definitely kids' clothes & needs are cheaper in Europe. It's a beautiful island with plenty of natural resources—a natural refuge.

NEW HEBRIDES

For full details, it would be wise to check with British or French Embassies, since matters may have changed recently due to recent independence.

1. MINISTRIES POSSIBLE: As for New Caledonia.
2. FAMILY NEEDED? Yes!

No one there now.

3. VISAS: All passengers must be in possession of a valid return or thru' ticket to their place of origin.
4. HEALTH: Malaria risk except in a couple of main cities.

FIJI

1. MINISTRIES POSSIBLE: As for New Caledonia.
2. FAMILY NEEDED? Yes, no one there at the moment.
3. VISAS: A one-month visa is given on arrival, which can easily be extended up to 6 mos. with show funds & an onward ticket.
4. HEALTH: Ok.
5. USEFUL INFO: Over 50% of the population is Indian whose relatives came from India years ago. They now largely run all the business & even a lot of the government. There is quite a flowing tourist trade here & it holds the University of the Pacific with students from all over. Fairly churchy, but really friendly.

TAHITI

1. MINISTRIES POSSIBLE: As for New Caledonia.
2. FAMILY NEEDED? Just one small team there now, so yes.
3. VISAS: French overseas territory, so French nationals can stay indefinitely, but they are strict with all other nationalities. An onward ticket is sufficient & not necessarily return to place of origin. Some nationalities are given 3 months on entry & others only 1, so check carefully beforehand if you're not a French citizen.
4. HEALTH: Ok.
5. USEFUL INFO: In Papeete housing is difficult to get since people from all the surrounding islands in French Polynesia come to the city for work, so camping equipment could come in handy. Things are expensive, so it'd

help to come with plenty, especially for children. Beautiful climate & people!

North Pacific Islands

GUAM

THIS IS THE MAIN OTHER ISLAND IN THE AREA, but in light of what Dad wrote in "Look Before You Leap", it has 3 big U.S. bases, so everyone there now is praying about it. It's a U.S. territory so no visa needed for U.S. Americans. Japanese fairly easy, but difficult for other nationalities to stay long.
