AS A RULE OUR UNITED TIME IS DINNER, which we all eat together on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays & Sundays, when we also hold a Church of Love. Limiting our united dinners to 4 nights a week makes them more meaningful to all, as well as giving 3 nights' opportunity to those who go out cafesinging in duos or with the children. Of course, during those 3 nights as well as at lunchtime 2 or more family units often get together for a more intimate meal, either in a given trailer or tent, or outdoors.

WHILE THE WEATHER WAS STILL COOL & the campground sparsely populated, we ate diner in the open & early enough to take advantage of the sun's warming rays.
