From Rafael & Pleiades; Europe: WE ARE REALLY EXCITED TO LIVE A MOBILE LIFE! We never dreamed we would ever live like this. Since we started 2½ months ago in a caravan & van the Lord has taught us a lot. We work now closer with our children & have learned how to witness with them as a family. We have found a new outreach in old folks homes & hospitals where the children sing & litness too. We now have 4 children—Teresa-6, Neshe-4, Stephen-3 & Heidi-4 months.

IN OUR TRAVELS THE LORD HAS DONE MANY LITTLE MIRACLES. For example, our laundry & how to wash it was one of the things we feared about getting mobile. The Lord has really encouraged us & sent people who offered to wash it. In one town the priest did it for us. In another town, the old folks home, in another a woman we hadn't even met sent her daughter to ask us for our dirty laundry so she could wash it! In the same place we found breakfast in a basket outside our door on 3 different days also! In the last 2½ months since being mobile we haven't paid more than \$4 on diesel, because the Lord has supplied free fuell

THIS CHANGE HAS RE-NEWED US SO MUCH, & each day we're so excited to see what will happen next. And the kids love it too! We are able to reach love it too! We are able to reach areas that are virtually untouched, which is a big encouragement, especially to the children, since we were in one big city for the last 3½ years. In the past we had made faith trips when we had only 2 children, but as our family grew we found it was too difficult without a caravan. We're so happy & thankful for the Mobile Ministry Letters to enable us to keep going & serving the Lord full-time!

cars are not available at all in these countries. If you break down, getting spares is an ardu

ous business, but the inevitable bureaucracy can be helped along with a greased palm! Patience & persistence are the keys.

ROADS are not too good & signs appear in Cyrillic Script (like Russian) in Yugoslavia & Bulgaria. (Yugoslavia & Bulgaria. THE BLACK MARKET flourishes in these countries as there is a shortage of everything, & queues for what there is.

Whilst the Black Market is illegal & frowned upon by the government, it is a tolerated institution as it brings in much needed foreign currency. You cannormally get 3 times as much as at the bank, so take as much in as possible.
