## Survival & Camping Tips!

"FOR THOSE IN BRITAIN WE RECOMMEND A COPY OF 'PROTECT & SURVIVE', a government publication available for 50 pence. It tells you how to make your home & family safe under nuclear attack, available from some booksellers. Here's a quote: 'The radioactive dust falling where the wind blows will bring the most widespread dangers of all. No part of the U.K. can be considered safe.' This is a conservative gov't. document! Lord help us to flee!"—Jacob & Rachel Scott.

"WE HAVE FOUND OUT FROM DIFFERENT S. AMERICAN EMBASSIES that it is wiser not to take a car & caravan with you but to buy one there. The Brasil Embassy said it's against the law to bring a car & caravan into Brasil. The Embassies for Argentina & Venezuela said that you could take a car & caravan but that at the border when entering you would have to pay 200% of its value. "FOR THOSE IN THE U.S.: Pawn shops & military stores carry a lot of survival items etc. for a much cheaper price than those found in ordinary retail shops. Also the Pro-Vita Corp. sells cheaper (I think) dehydrated foods than Sam Andy. For example a No. 10 can of beef flavored textured vegetable protein costs \$4.80. Orders over \$250 get a 10% discount which is returned to you after you've

paid in full. For a \$3 fee you can become a 'distributor' (probably a gimmick) & pay 'cost' for items instead of the 'suggested retail price'. Their address: PRO-VITA Corp., 1060 N. Armando Street, Anaheim, Calif. 92806."—Sunny Day; U.S.A.

"I FOUND THE CHEAPEST WAY TO FLY TO THE CARIBBEAN from London. Usual airlines cost £500 to Jamaica. If you go by Laker to Miami first from London, then get a flight from Miami to the Caribbean, it's only about £160!"—Matthew Artist (now in Caribbean).

SUNBURN REMEDY: "We recently learned about using the aloe plant to heal skin. The leaves are thick, & you just slice them & coat the skin with the inside. It doesn't hurt & helps to heal burns & other skin problems quickly. We also learned another tip from the manager of the campground about mosquito bites. You can use white vinegar to help relieve itching. It's just temporary, but if you let the kids apply it themselves, it does provide some relief as well as keep them from scratching the bites & possibly causing infection."—Nathan & Daystar; USA. (An ancient Bible herb!—Dad.)

"FOR CAMPERS, TRAILERS & ALL SORTS OF EQUIPMENT, England has it. The bottom has recently fallen out of the car market & people are waking up to the Crash as they are liquidating their luxury items, campers etc. for cheap. It's a buyers' market!"—Phinehas & Rebecca; B.I. V.S.

"POINTERS FOR REFUGES: We found cats to be wonderful protection against snakes, rats, mice, moles, gophers, harmful insects & bothersome birds on our refuge. They're clean, terrific hunters & beautiful to watch. Just don't overfeed them. Two have proven better than one for us. We feed them a little cat

food & a little milk in the morning & they have to catch their own meat. They usually have to be at least 5 months old or so before they can be expected to start performing, & it doesn't hurt to feed a pregnant cat a little meat to insure her & her kittens are healthy." (Amen!-D.)—Keros & Jeddah; U.S.A.

"WE CAME ACROSS PLANS ON HOW TO BUILD A SMALL WIND-POWERED GENERATOR. It consists of only 2 car batteries, a car generator, some various pieces of wood & sheet metal, some wire, nuts & bolts. With only a small wind it will supply more than enough electricity for a trailer or small house & also stores electricity for when there's no wind. It's called 'Homemade 6-Volt Wind Electric Plants' by H.F. McColly & Fosterbuck. It could be very useful for an independent refuge."—Shadrach & Bethesda; USA. (Can you send an address?)

"WE BOUGHT A CAR CIGARETTE LIGHTER & tape recorder adapter for it & wired it to the 12 v. light in the trailer, & now we can play tapes on 12 v. We found the 12v. light cheaper to use than propane, provided you have a good battery &

recharge it at regular intervals (3-4 hours). Propane mantles have proved costly as they break almost every time we move."—Aaron & Serena; Canada. (Just B sure Ur tape's 12V!)

"WHEN TRAVELLING IN FRANCE BY TRAIN in brother & sister teams, get a 'carte couple' entitling one of the 2 to a 50% reduction. You don't even have to be married!"—Abishai.

"WE FOUND THAT BY PARKING OUR CARAVAN on the east side of campgrounds next to good shade provided by trees on the west side, the sun warms up the caravan in the morning but by the time the hot afternoon sun hits we are under total shade cover."—Abishai.

"THERE IS A GROUP OF WOMEN WHO SELL 'MENSTRUAL SPONGES'. They might be very practical for survival. They are made of natural sponge & can be washed & used
