DIAPER WASHING TIP: "Washing nappies (diapers) by hand I found it very difficult to get out doo-doo stains even after soaking. I seldom have the time to scrub out the nappies immediately after changing. I found that by using a bar of old-fashioned laundry soap (not meant for bathing), I could put a coating of soap all over the stains before putting it in the bucket. When I was able to wash them, the stains came out so easily!" —Eileen; Europe.

"BOTH MY CHILDREN CAUGHT YEAST INFECTIONS which gave them severe diaper rashes (normal creams & ointments only made them worse). I was instructed to keep them as dry as possible with powder (Ed.: Cornstarch safer, cheaper & more effective than talcum powder!) & to clean their bottoms with a vinegar-water solution (approx. 2 tablespoons vinegar to 1 cup water depending on the sensitivity of baby's skin, as vinegar stings) which provides an acid medium that discourages the growth of yeast. So with prayer & vinegar the rashes cleared up, TTL!" —Sunny Day; U.S.A.

"DOES ANYONE KNOW OF ANY NATURAL TOOTH TOUGHENERS for my toddler as her teeth are not strong & are getting very chipped." (Calcium) —Elisiah & Damaris; Pacific.

"BAKING SODA WORKS GREAT AS A FABRIC SOFTENER, especially for diapers. It also works great to soak diapers for sensitive skin & as a sponge bath for rash rashes." —Lydia & Marc; Pacific (Ed.: How much soda do you use for softener?)

DIAPER RASH REMEDY: "A weak solution of boric acid (1 teaspoonful to a cup of water) is very good for stubborn diaper rash. First wash with soap & warm water, then apply the boric acid solution, then cover with a good cream like Desitin etc." —Lucy; Europe.

DIAPER RASH REMEDY: "We tried Vitamin E cream on Tabitha's rash & it worked great. Also when she had thrush, pure blackberry syrup, applied with a cotton swab 3 times a day, worked very well. Be sure to rinse mouth before using syrup & after nursing." —Jay & Joyce; Eur.

"I'D LIKE TO SEE A CHILDREN'S FAMILY SONGBOOK or for the FN to start publishing a series of simple songs & chords so we can teach the children. I know many songs but not the chords." —Fortify & Ruth; U.S.A.

"FOR STAINED RUBBER BABY PANTS, rub a solution of lemon & salt on the stain & hang in the sun to dry. Rewash & the stain will be gone." —Gabriel & Sky; S. America.

fever. The doctor said after 2 operations there's nothing more he can do to help him, that he's going to die very soon. It has been 9 months & his condition has not changed. Please pray for us." —Mel & Rejoice; S.A.
