LESSONS LEARNED DURING OUR KP MINISTRY:

1. **VISION:** "Training & Shepherding Babes" #734:114-121 really helped me to train our children like new disciples, lead & inspire them to obey rather than drive'em.

2. **OPEN DOORS:** When phoning for contacts, we mentioned we had a children's group, & the kids got us in where we wouldn't have otherwise.

3. **TRAINING:** We don't need perfection, just willing hearts. The kids were usually the ones who pushed us to get out. After a while they got tired of practising-- "Enough talk; let's get out!"

4. **SIZE OF GROUPS:** The ideal is 4 to 6 children. More can be confusing & defeat the whole purpose: a united sample. Quality not quantity!

5. **STRUCTURE:** Make sure each group has a pillar-- a child who can sing loud & clear & lead the other children.

6. **AUDIENCES:** Start small. Begin with friends & relatives & other family members as audiences. Gradually build up to small crowds in parks & daycare centres. Try to have the kids get some experience singing in public to build their confidence before tackling large crowds.

7. **PREPARATION:** Allow lots of time to prepare, pray to-

gether & go over pointers before leaving for appointments. Avoid the rushy spirit. Practice the day before. (They explode in practice & have nothing left for the performance!)

8. **FOLLOW UP:** Get names &

addresses at singing appointments. Go up to the director & talk privately with him about helping with a donation to cover costs; do this after the sample. Be faithful to write thank-you letters. Happy singing! (Amen!)

One team shares their experience in buying video equipment & getting it to S.A.!

I'D LIKE TO SHARE OUR EXPERIENCES ACQUIRING VIDEO EQUIPMENT since reading the inspiring vision for worldwide Family fellowship that Dad has given us. After searching the shops in London & reading several informative magazines, the best being called "What Video?", as well as the Family News, we decided upon either of two portables: The JVC HR2200 or Panasonic's new NV3000.

SEVERAL DIFFERENT SALESMEN AT SEVERAL DIFFERENT SHOPS ADVISED US that the picture from the Panasonic 3000 was the best possible on the market. Also, being released five or six months after the JVC, it had some new features such as a quartz direct-drive motor & new head breakthroughs which means the heads are supposed to last longer than any other brand.

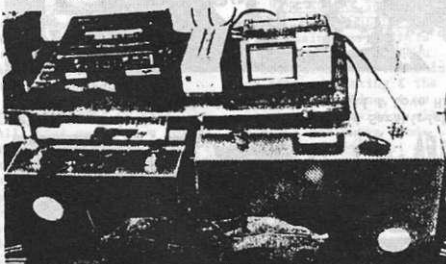
AFTER SEVERAL WEEKS OF USING THE PANASONIC NV3000 together with the JVC 610 TV monitor, we've had splendid results. TYU! The JVC CX610 color TV is also a video monitor when taping & has a built-in tuner which means we can record direct from television on our VCR. JVC's latest camera, the GX88 (also called a Ferguson CV20) has the electronic view-finder built in & a 6X1 zoom lens with added macro facilities.

WE ALSO FOUND THAT FOAM-PADDED ALUMINUM LUGGAGE (see pic) costs a little more but will protect our equipment for life. As Dad says, "Be not afraid of their prices!" Hope our experience & tips help you to enjoy happy videoring for Jesus! Love, Denise & family.

SOUTH & have landed in South America! The Lord did miracles to help us get here, 5 adults, 2 children & 18 pieces of luggage, including our video equipment. At a wonderful going-away party with the DAF, we had specific prayer regarding our baggage, that we'd have no problems with either that or the customs officials.

DEAR DAS CHRIS & SIMON RUSHED US TO THE AIRPORT on the day of our flight, almost late. It turned out to be surely the Lord's doing as we were so late that they whizzed our luggage thru with scarcely a glance at all the bags, even the video suitcases which we had to stop at the gate to collect our sales tax refunds. From Paris we flew directly to South America, avoiding Miami, as we had heard from several sources, including Faithy's own testimony, that for anyone to land in America after having been gone for some time could be in for some interrogation or difficulties.

AS WE WERE CARRYING PRECIOUS CARGO we felt responsible to avoid as many difficulties as possible, although visiting loved ones can be a blessing. The Lord had warned us in our particular circumstances that we had better watch out.

LANDING IN SOUTH AMERICA, we were very glad we had taken prayerful precautions, as we discovered that the airline personnel had been very rough with our luggage & several straps & handles had been torn off our luggage. We had been very cautious with our two video suitcases, keeping them with us continually (they measured exactly the limit allowed for one person to carry on board!), never turning our backs on them or leaving them anywhere insecure. The fact that we lost nothing was a very great relief & testimony to the Lord & His desire to inspire His children with what
