ME WATCHED TY AT THO DIFFERENT ITMES, the first in kiev where when we went to navim at the Dnepr River we



had travelled outside Russia to a few countries such as Italy giving concerts. He spoke no English, but his wife, who studied at the university, did. They were very nice to us 6 invited us for a very good meaty dinner, improvising on the common things available at the moment such as cucumbers, which were the only vegetable we saw for our 17 days in Russia except for some occasional 6 expensive tomatoes, WE HAD ABSOLUTELY NO FRESH FRUIT or even saw any the whole time there, except that in one store we found some delicious grape juice, 6 in another city we found some apple juice which was more like apple sauce. In almost all cases, storebought food is packaged very poorly with its contents simply stated rather dully with little design or antwork, as there is only type 8 no competition, only one company—that of the State. This is what is sed different at first from the West, as there is no publicity, not all these neon signs, not much color, no fancy stores generally, but just what is necessary to serve its purpose. There is no ponography at all either or pictures of women being used to portray something. Homen have equal rights 8 offen responsibilities.

MELL, NOW THAT I'VE TALK-PD SO MUCH ABOUT THE COUNTRY, let me tell you about some of our exciting experiences. We were really thankful that we had come with a car, as we were able to move around much more freely 8 were completely able to decide what we wanted to do once we were in the city of our itinerary. Plus it proved to be much cheaper. Our entire expense for 17 days was

only \$400, so it can be very cheap.

IN KIEV ME MENT TO A BALLET MICH MAS SUGGESTED TO US BY OUR INTOURIST GUIDE at the campgrounds. We sat right up in front & saw one of the most fantastic shows that we had ever seen & were both just breathless. They started singing & then danning & had such wariety & humour that we were taken away & both kids were just silent, watching during the whole two hours.

ATTERWARDS, AS WE MERE WALKING TOWARDS THE HETRO, we casually started to talk to these two simple girls who were taking an interest in Vera who was smiling at them. It turned out that they were taking the Metro also & were 2 of the sing-ers in the ensemble. After a little more talk & making friends, one of them invited us to their house. So we took another bus & got to their apartment.

WE HAD A GOOD SHACK HE-PROVISED FROM THE FOOD AVALLABLE—cucumbers of course, but with hard boiled aggs & cheese which was all very good & satisfying. I spent a lot of time talking to the husband who played a tressured tape of Boney H in the background which his father had gotten him one time when he went to the West for work. Their house had almost no furniture at all except their bedroom & a fantastic piano. He opened up 2 bottles of champagns which we all finished off, & so we stayed up till real late talking.
