Luc (Australian) & Marie

(French new disciple). We

spent the last months in

France working on support,

finishing our beautiful

slide show with the Family

flannelgraphs, & witnessing

& cafe singing.

BEING IN A CARAVAN MADE

ALL THIS SO MUCH EASIER,

economical & pleasant. By

the way, we had borrowed

\$2,000 from Matthieu's par-

ents by faith to buy the

caravan two years ago, &

8 months later his grand-

mother died leaving him an

inheritance of exactly

\$2,700, enough to pay our

debt & the 10%! How God

supplies!

SO WE JUST SOLD ALL THAT

WE HAD & put our funds to-

gether to make the trip.

The Lord really blessed our

united effort, & we were

able to find tickets at only

\$450 per adult.

WE MIRACULOUSLY MET THE

BRETHREN IN OUR NEW COUNTRY

& were surprised to find

that there were 50-60 adults

with about 30 children in

the capital city. Our flight

was on June 7, & we were

inspired to arrive & see

the brethren fellowshiping

& really getting it together.

WELL, BECAUSE OF THE HU-

MIDITY & SMOG, Luke began to

have asthma. So because of

that & our personal burden

to pioneer some of the un-

touching cities, we headed

out to a delightful city

with blue skies, surrounded

by mountains in a desert.

I CAN'T TELL YOU ENOUGH

HOW SHEEPY, receptive and

smiling the natives are

here. Some are not even ac-

customed to seeing blond,

light-skinned whites, & they

often stop to touch or look

at the children.

AFTER ONLY ONE MONTH HERE

we had won 2 FF souls--God

bless our beautiful, French

babe Marie, who really at-

tacked, even though she knew

very little Spanish. We have

been able to meet several

influential people already,

as here the people take

pride in befriending for-

eigners.

THEN THE LORD DID A MIR-

ACLE IN SUPPLYING OUR LITTLE

HOUSE after 1 1/2 months.

It was a miracle because the

houses for rent here are few

& expensive. This house was

not even publicised for

rent, but the nearby Catholic

nun was the one who found

us the house & contacted the

owner for us.

SO NOW WE ARE IN OUR LOVE-

LY 2 1/2 BEDROOM HOME, half-

furnished, with telephone &

lovely flower garden, safely

enclosed with a high wall,

3 blocks from the centre of

town. Already we're receiv-

ing visitors daily, & two

souls prayed with us to re-

ceive Jesus this morning!

THE COUNTRYSIDE HERE IS IN-

TERESTED. We have been

able to renew fellowship with

brethren who had lost con-

tact when the chain & their

crew left. The brethren here

are so sweet but dispersed

& needy of fellowship again.

ALL THESE VICTORIES COULD

NOT BE POSSIBLE WITHOUT A

FEW BATTLES, & the Enemy has

done his best to try to stop,

discourage & practically

kill us. We've all been

touched with severe diarrhea,

even though we purified our

drinking water, & the many

changes in food, climate,

bacteria, etc. are something

that everyone coming here

should be prepared to face.

SO THEY SHOULD BRING ALONG

PLENTY OF FAITH, as well as

things like baby clothes,

radios, videos, projectors &

things like that which cost

much more here. But with

plenty of faith & courage,

these inconveniences are

nothing compared to the re-

wards of obeying & following

Jesus & Dad into all the

world. WLY all so much!(GBY!)

SO HELPING THIS ELDERLY

LADY THRU CUSTOMS REALLY

HELPED US TOO. We stayed

at a hotel owned by a Bap-

tist family who immediately

opened their arms to us &

the kids. The wife told us

about a large house she had

outside of town that was

for rent, so after praying

about it & our not being

able to contact the brethren

thru their phone number--

we didn't know if they were

still in the country--we

decided to rent the house.

THE COUPLE SUPPLIED US

WITH LOTS OF FURNITURE FOR

THE HOUSE & we were all set.

After living there for 2

days the couple from the

Family had gotten our note

that we placed in Poste

Restante for them & they

were really surprised to

see how the Lord provided

a place for us. The church

people had also offered us

a couple of teaching jobs

which helped us get started.

NOW WE ARE IN OUR THIRD

MONTH HERE & have left our

first house & moved together

with the Family--a couple &

their 2 children. After liv-

ing alone for 2 years in

the U.S. we really missed

the close fellowship & in-

spiration of living with an-

other family, so we teamed

up with each other.

THE TWO HUSBANDS TEACH

ENGLISH to the rich upper

class, both teenagers &

adults, & have several sheep

among their students. André

also tutors some of his

young students in math.

WE HAVE ALSO FORMED A SING-

ING GROUP OF OUR CHILDREN

who sing several songs in

Spanish that they learned

from Singing Sam's "Amor"

tape. They sang at a park

on Saturday, & just recently

they sang at a peanut butter

factory & were given 10 kilos

of peanut butter!

WE HOPE THIS TESTIMONY

INSPIRED OTHER FAMILIES in

the U.S. & Europe to make

the break & come to the

sunny climes & happy people.

Guam: Full of Military Bases!

IT'S OKAY FOR 'PASSING THRU' BUT YOU WOULDN'T WANT TO LIVE THERE!

From Ephesians 1A; (Now in

Japan):

WE HAVE SPENT TWO YEARS

IN GUAM, so we are sending

this information on the

island as requested by

Bithia Masseuse. We hope it

will be of help to many.

GUAM, U.S.A.: LIKE DAD

SAID, ALL AMERICAN TERRI-

TORIES USUALLY ARE MILITARY

OCCUPIED, which is true.

Guam has 5 military bases

& is only 36 miles long &

8 miles wide. It is the

only U.S. territory in the

Pacific where you can re-

ceive food stamps, free

housing, etc. (besides of

course the State of Hawaii).

A SINGLE MOTHER CAN EASILY

OBTAIN FOOD STAMPS (approx.

\$500 worth for Bithia's fami-

ly size) & free housing

along with a living allow-

ance from welfare. Guam is

a very easy place to live,

as it has no seasons other

than summer year round.

FROM MY OWN PERSONAL EX-

PERIENCE however, I would

not recommend it for anyone

to just "live" there. But it

is a good place to "pass

thru" temporarily if she's

on her way to Asia or the

Orient & needs to wait for

visas, passports or what-

ever, providing she has the

faith to leave before the

island is blown off the map.

SHE ALSO WANTED INFO SUCH

AS ABOUT SCHOOLS: They are

typical American schools.

English is spoken. Catholic

schools are a lot better &

cost about \$80 per month,

about \$20 more per child.

TRANSPORTATION: No mass

transit, no buses--only

taxis, cabs & hitch-hiking.

APTS. OR HOUSES: Usually

rent is between \$200-\$300

monthly for a furnished 2-

bedroom place, & it is easy

to find one.

COST OF LIVING: ABOUT TWICE

AS EXPENSIVE AS CALIFORNIA,

especially food, as it must

all be shipped in.
