GETHER, we headed out on the

road, all 9 of us, first of

all to a little beach house

that a friend let us use.

We were able to spread some

of the Lord's light into the

darkness there, & TTL we were

able to witness to many of

the local people & to encour-

age the little handful of Chris-

tians there to "Change the

World".

BEFORE LEAVING OUR BASE,

we had put together & printed

up a program to present to

churches, containing a couple

of songs, a slide show, a

short skit & a salvation

prayer at the end taken from

the Baby Tract. The program

lasted about an hour, & we

had used it at our own Church

of Love at home several times,

leading souls to the Lord with

the simple little prayer at

the end.

THE LOCAL PASTOR AT THE ON-

LY CHURCH IN THE AREA WAS

VERY HAPPY & encouraged when

we went to visit him & have

fellowship with him. The fol-

lowing couple of evenings we

did programs in his church.

It was located in a little

back alley with no electrici-

ty, but TTL we were able to

borrow a small generator to

put on a slide show at the

end of our meeting. We shared

with them about witnessing to

others, & before leaving we

got their addresses for the

Indonesian Mail Ministry so

that they can continue to

be fed.

KIDS RETURNED TO OUR BASE

HOME, & Daniel, Sam & I

went by motorbikes to a

port town. We took with us

a lot of lit & a projector,

& we boarded a ferry to

cross over to another is-

land. There the roads are

rough & the people are a

bit wilder, so we had to

change our method a little.

IN THE LARGEST CITY,

we were able to hit their re-

creation resort area & get

out a lot of lit, but in

the smaller cities we went

shop to shop & were able to

stay with families along the

way. In some areas we had

adopt a "hit & run" type of

mission. We would ride into

town, gather a crowd & lit-

erally throw out handfulls

of lit. Everyone would dive

on it & grab it while we'd

ride off before anyone got

mad or even found out who

we were. We'd ride out of

town leaving the whole

street of people with lit

in their hands.

WE DID THIS IN EVERY TOWN

WE ENTERED, knowing that as

the Lord said, His Word ne-

ver returns void, & all of

those interested can write

in to our mail ministry for

follow up. Telling people

about Jesus is not against

the law here, but some lo-

icals might not like it too

much. When we entered a town

where we intended to stay

the night, we couldn't get

out the lit like that an-

yma, but rather would make

friends with & stay in the

homes of local people or in

very cheap travellers' inns.

After a week on the road(in

places there were hardly

any roads at times) we re-

turned to our home, tired

but very inspired. (GBY!)
