ME NEVER REALISED HOW EASY IT WOULD BE TO START AN "OPEN THE DOOR FOR THE CHILDREN" HIMISTRY until AN "OPPH THE DOOR FOR THE CHILDREN" MINISTRY until we tried it, & we were shocked!
