near Larn Luang Rd. Free lit is available for distribution outside of Bangkok & for Pioneer Homes & poverty cases. Lit usually costs about .07% (7stang) per piece. P.O. Boxes are not too hard to obtain. There are many employment agencies at which to get domestic help & there are also many housing agents. Houses are usually around 4,500% per month plus a deposit of one months rent. You usually have to pay utilities yourself. Tap water is filtered & chlorinated & shouldn't hurt you but there are no guarantees. Much more dangerous is ice from we-knownot-where that you get in cold drinks at the shop. This is very dangerous upcountry.

There are many public & private hospitals. They use mostly western medicines & methods. Some good public hospitals are Chulalonglorn, Rajvithi, Ramathibodi & Bangrak. Bangrak specialises in VD treatment & is almost free. It is on Bangrak Rd. Treatment & medicine has been provisioned at Chulalongkorn & Ramathibodi. Even if you pay at public hospitals it is very cheap.

Any servants you employ will probably expect about 1000 per month. Some will want to live in, others won't. Be sure to photo-copy her Identity Card & keep your valuables locked up. Don't tempt the poor to steal!

Jobs are available to teach english & with some agencies involved with refugees. Lice are prevalent throughout Thailand so beware. Tax clearances are required for anyone staying in the country over 90 days. They are obtained from the Revenue Department & you can't exit the country without one. Work permits are legally required for any type of work in the country but this law is weakly enforced.

THAI LANGUAGE That is a tonal language meaning a change of tone creates a new word without changing the vowels or consonents. There are 5 tones: MIDDLE TONE which is a normal straight tone, LOW TONE which is the tone of confirmation in english, RISING TONE which is the tone we use in english for a question, FALLING TONE which is an exclamation tone in english, & HIGH TONE such as the tone we use when we say "bank".

There are approximately 28 commonly used vowels & about 44 commonly used consonants. They are not hard to learn. if you learn a few a day. Rather than learn a phonetic alphabet to learn to speak Thai why not simply learn the Thai alphabet? Initial progress will be slower but you'll eventually pull out far ahead of those who can only speak but can't read. It'll enable you to read, use a dictionary, & learn correct pronunciation more clearly & accurately. Like having a baby, it shouldn't be painful, just hard work. I strongly recommend learning the Thai alphabet & not using a phonetic one.

There are some good Thai courses available. The one at AUA is highly recommended but expensive. Many brethren have derived great benefit from it. Taking a course is not absolutely necessary but spending time studying is. The most fluent foreign speakers of Thai did not learn thru a course but by diligent daily study of Thai & actual practical usage out on the field, especially upcountry & living in Thai homes. If you want to learn you easily can for free! Inability to speak Thai well becomes an increasingly worse testimony as your stay here becomes longer & longer.
