the younger children usually have Get Out with their families or play time.

AFTER 2 PM LUNCH & 3 PM SIESTA, afternoon classes begin at 4 pm. The older children usually have an hour's worth of homework or reading in this period, assigned from the morning. In this hour the teachers can prepare for the afternoon classes from 5-6 pm. We have such a wide variety of subjects to offer the children, from dance classes by Topaz, how to read music by Sarah, sewing for the girls by Patience, Greek or Spanish songs from Manuel & Abel, Art Class by Lydia or Karen, and much, much more.

ONE QUOTE WHICH WE REALLY STRIVE TO LIVE is from the Sara Davidito Letter No. 3, par. 45, "Teaching is Giving & Sharing—it's part of our life-style! It's something you can & should be doing constantly when around children of all ages."

WELL, HERE WE ARE AROUND CHILDREN LITERALLY OF ALL AGES & at all times, so it's been such a blessing to have everyone give a helping hand. Paul &

others would weekly take time to take the older boys & girls out for a hike in the woods, sharing with them many valuable scouting tips, or Peter Polish would give the boys guitar lessons, etc. For the younger children, we'd give them videos, walks, art class, & even they would benefit from Topaz's dance class or performance classes from Manuel, etc. in the afternoon hours!

WE DESIGNED A SIMPLE WEEKLY REPORT CARD to keep diligent oversight of the progress of our flock, grading them on a 10 point system for their performance in their various classes, along with their General Behaviour throughout the week. This was a great blessing for parents who were busy in the studio, or busy with the urgent affairs of the camp, to know how their children are doing in each scholastic area of their life, along with how their attitude has been in class! We'd compile their weekly marks into a monthly report card, then reward the shiner students who had the highest average at the end of the month!

OUR WEEKLY CHILDCARE MEETINGS, & DESPERATE PRAYER FOR OUR CHILDREN helped us to avoid many pitfalls. "Dad said he believed in committing the children to the Lord daily...& showing the Lord you really mean business. I believe this desperate prayer has been

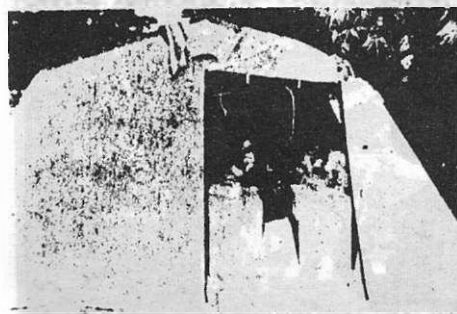

OUR SCHOOL SYSTEM RECENTLY CAME TO AN ABRUPT & SUDDEN HALT with the arrival of the New Year & Dad's World Series Videos, letting us know of the extreme shortage of time, & how we must do all we can right now to produce the musical tools for the Family before the war breaks out in its final atomic fury.

UPON DAD'S SUGGESTION, WE SLOWED DOWN OUR SCHOOLING A BIT, as they'd gone nearly all summer & fall without a school break, & most all hands were needed on deck so the HMS MWM could make its final departure. But in these emergency situations & trying times, it seems our schooling is still able to flourish. Though we've had to somewhat disband the structure we had set up, yet we've been able to continue with our classes by just carrying a little bit heavier load & taking the responsibility He wants to give us to help our Family grow.

FOR THE OLDER TWO GROUPS, sometimes nearly 20 children would join for a 2 hour rehashing of Dad's newest videos, taught by only one teacher, explaining to them where these places are on the map, giving them in-depth World History & Geography classes, & letting them know where it is going to be safe during the war, & what places will suffer from conventional warfare afterwards, etc. & their curiosity & hunger for world events seems quite insatiable. Anytime you have to share with them of the troubles to come, it's a good time to drive home to them the vital importance of their ministry in these last days. "They are going to have a real ministry of Love, & be a real blessing & encouragement to others, to inspire their faith & to help others." (890:7)

MY NAME IS LEE. I'M KOREAN, 29 YEARS OLD. Something wonderful has happened which I have never experienced before in all my 29 years! I can't describe exactly what it is, but a new strength has passed thru my body & made my heart bigger. I will never forget that wonderful & exciting feeling I had that day. It was around 5 o'clock on Sept. 26, 1980.

AT THAT TIME I WAS STUDYING ENGLISH in a course for members of companies & government officials which my boss arranged for me. It is a special 6-month intensive course that every Korean man wants to be able to attend.

ON THAT DAY, THE FIRST DAY OF A NEW CLASS, the contents of the lecture shocked my sleeping heart! The teacher was telling us that his whole life had completely changed & become totally new after he received Jesus. During his powerful testimony I became so curious what made him so confident & strong yet gentle. During our break I wanted to know more, & he told me it was Jesus' love & that after we receive Jesus He never leaves us no matter

Before that day my life was so full of sins that I had kept deep inside.

From the day I got saved I stopped smoking because I didn't want to fill my body with smoke where Jesus is. I had tried many times to quit. Now my wife also

has received Jesus. In Him we will live on as a new couple.

IN THE MIDST OF ALL THIS I EXPERIENCED SOME VERY MOVING WORDS from a Family member. When departing from each other he said, "You are always in our prayers." I have never experienced such loving words which made my heart cry. And later I knew this is Jesus' promise, that if we give love we will receive love. (Amos! WLBPPY!)

NOW I KNOW THE REASON WHY I AM HERE in the world —to enjoy God's love forever & to help others to enjoy it. Jesus is not just a story. He really lives with & in me & has filled that void in my heart. The more I think about how He loves me, a man so full of faults, the more I can't help but thank Him. Now I want to enjoy this happiness & help others to enjoy this happiness also. I will do all I can for Christ so that many people here can have peace with God. I love the Family here who are reaching Korea & who really love these people.
