From Eli, Tarah & Pearl; Europe:

JUST ABOUT 2 YEARS AGO (just before Christmas), we decided after reading some inspiring testimonies of children's singing ministries, to make plans to do some kind of a show for Christmas time & perform for a segment of society which is often lonely & forgotten—the grandmothers & grandfathers in old people's homes.

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INSTEAD OF DOING THE STANDARD CHRISTMAS PLAY we felt inspired to do something which we finally called, "The Real Meaning of Christmas", the story of a young boy searching & wondering as he looks into a store window which displays the nativity scene surrounded by a variety of gifts & toys, what Christmas is all about.

SUDDENLY AN ANGEL APPEARS (played by Pearl), saying that God sent her to answer all his questions. She invites him to meet "Tommy" & then the children act out "Tommy" after which he asks if the angel knows another example. So she invites him to meet Madame Heart (Megan), & the angel gives him the key of love which of course changes her life & she sings John 3:18.

THEN THE ANGEL ASKS HIM IF HE'D LIKE TO KNOW THE SECRET & then asks

the audience if they would, at which time we all come from behind the backdrop & pray with everyone to receive Jesus. And then the children sing some Christmas songs.

WE WERE THRILLED WITH THE RESULTS of the 7-8 shows that first Christmas during their vacation. Before that, it seemed like an impossible task to get something together with the children, but having a deadline is what we really needed. TYJI We had done some restaurant singing with them, but it was the first time that they performed as a group & the beginning of what we later called "Lovelight" or "La Lumiere d'Amour!"

THEN WE DIDN'T DO ANY MORE PERFORMANCES (as it was a Christmas play) until the following summer when the Lord pushed us into a commitment to do some shows. One thing that I wented to mention here is that we learned when we tried to find places to perform at Christmas time that if we mentioned who we were, i.e. a group of Christians, then more often than not our offer of a free show would be turned down. So the second time (the following summer) Jonathan, who became our very good PR & front man, just and that he represented a group of children who do shows for free & would they be interested.

THIS METHOD WORKED REALLY

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WELL & even when we would perform, they
would always love the show & the children so
there would never be any reproach made about
its content or our intentions. PTEL In fact, at
the end of the shows we pass out our own
LIN which explains that we are missionaries
& we've been invited back & received some
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THAT SUMMER WE CHANGED THE THEME TO "CHANGE THE WORLD" & started out the play with 3 of the older children discussing the horrible mess that the world is in & wondering what they can do to change it when an angel (Pearl again) appears & goes through the "Tommy" & "Heart" skits, finishing by praying & then singing some Family songs to which Pearl added some movements.

WE ALSO, AT THAT TIME, WERE INSPIRED TO CONTACT THE NEWSPAPERS. The result of that was a very inspiring article & photo. After this second group of shows, we began to catch the vision more of what the Lord wanted us to do using the children's little troupe which now included Joseph (3), John-David (4), Daniel (6), Megan (8) & Michael (11).

AFTER PERFORMING AGAIN AT CHRISTMAS TIME & having 2 more articles written, we put together our own LIN & a

photo album which included several very inspiring letters of recommendation which we received from the old folks' homes. Because we offer the show for free, we feel rather free about asking them for letters of recommendation & we've received about 1 for every 4-5 shows. These have been a real help in presenting our work to the public, giving us some credibility, therefore avoiding a lot of questions about sects & cults, etc.

ALSO, THESE LETTERS, PLUS THE NEWSPAPER ARTICLES have been an enormous help in our provisioning & PR. So in fact, because we live in a country where there's been a considerable amount of persecution against sects, we put this social outreach, i.e. the children's performances, as our main calling card & just as Dad said, the children have become our biggest testimony & most powerful witness! PTL!

OUR MOST ENCOURAGING & SUCCESSFUL OUTREACH WITH THE CHILDREN took place this summer. Early in the spring, we met a woman who suggested that we present our little show to a group of 13 retirement homes which are very well funded. She insisted that we skt to be paid as they could afford it as well as to ask for lodging & meals which, she also explained, was very normal & acceptable.



so WE PUT TOGETHER A LETTER & a collage of newspaper articles & letters of recommendation as well as a group of photos of the children performing & sent them off. We received 3 responses which really surprised us because we hadn't even mentioned how much, etc. One of those places accepted to have us & it was 800 kms. from our Home.

SO WE DECIDED TO CONTACT ALL KINDS OF OLD FOLKS' HOMES, retirement villages, children's homes & vacation camps along the entire coast by writing to the administrative centers of the government & asking for such addresses. To our happy surprise, we received hundreds of addresses & finally narrowed down our choice to 2 areas along the coast. So after contacting many places by mail & making arrangements, we found 15 old folk's homes & 2 vacation camps that wanted us to come. In doing this we discovered that it was much better to offer to do the show for free & just ask that they participate with our travel expenses. If we didn't ask anything, many times they gave more than we would have

asked. Not only that, but we could always say (to the public or newspaper) that the shows are done for free, etc., which makes a much bigger impression.

WE HAD ALREADY 2 VANS, one partially equiped for camping & the other completely empty. There are 13 of us (7 children & 6 adults) plus at the time 2 pregnant mommies. We had the vision to fix up the vans with real good materials, in fact, the best possible, so that they would be a good testimony & also to prepare them so that we could eventually move into them.

THE LORD REALLY SUPPLIED EVERY

THE LORD REALLY SUPPLIED EVERY-THING, from top grade plywood & insolation material to skylights, upholstery material for the cushions & even down to the smallest hinge & screw. Our faithful national disciple Jonathan provisioned up a storm. We figured out that he provisioned about \$ 3000 worth of materials from approximately 25 different companies. PTLI

were wondering & worrying a bit whether we'd have enough room for everyone, we received a call from WS relaying a message from Dad that he had a caravan free for the summer & would it help us in our travels! Well, what could we say but simply PTL & marvel at how in tune Dad is & how wonderful & loving this Family of Love is with such a concerned & loving shepherd. With the tremendous work-load & descisions Dad has daily, he still finds time to take care of such unimportant (seemingly) details as our housing need for our summer travels—this absolutely amazed us & really touched our hearts & made us feel so loved. GBY Dad for your faithful loving tender care of us little sheep—WE LOVE YOU!

AND THE LORD HAD EVEN MIGHT-IER MIRACLES AHEAD as we ventured South to arrive in the most popular resort area in the heighth of the season looking for someone to help us with free camping. Jonathan, who was provisioning, got a number of a camping where there was still room & when he phoned the guy surprisingly agreed to let us come. He said we could stay a few days only.

WELL, WE ENDED UP STAYING THERE

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25 DAYS, 13 days for free & the rest for half
price which in fact was paid for by Jonathan's
mother & the friends whom we ministered to
while there. It was a 4-star camping as well,
which is quite a testimony as many campers
