38. DAD DOESN'T MAKE US SIT AROUND PRAYING AND SINGING WHILE THE FOOD GETS COLD, like in some Homes I've visited. When food comes from the kitchen your pray-ing ought to be done! Dad always eats his meals when they're hot. This is just common courtesy and sense, but, like Dad says, "Com-mon sense just isn't too common."

39. MAKE SURE ALSO THAT YOUR

42. ANOTHER THING IS SURVIVAL. SURVIVAL FOODS AND SUPPLIES! You should store canned food and eat fresh foods. We buy several extra canned goods weekly for Survival storage.

If you just start something but don't fix it or improve it, you're no handyman. Anybody can destroy. In fact, we've had too many people who can destroy!

Pioneering India And The Surrounding Countries How It Was First Done!

From Paul Kings, India: CBY, Dear Family! I pray this little summery of how India was first pioneered will be an inspiration to you. Of course, it is not a complete history, as I wasn't personally involved in everything in India, and also the dates are approximate, as I was coming in and out of India so often, but this is the main story! PTL for what He has done!

LAMP - LIGHT

When we first came to India, the Lord gave Dad 3 basic letters for we that applied to the work here. They ware: - "SQUEEZE DON'T JERK"; "STOP, LOOK AND LISTEN"; and "SO YOU WANT TO BE A LEADER." we also had from the Lord "CALL OF INDIA", MANNISHI OF HYDERABAD" and "RAGS TO RICKES". Thank God for these wonder working words that really helped us so much - a real "lamp unto our feet and light unto our path."

EARLY PIONEERS

The first people to come to India were: Samson, Are, Michaiah, Theaphilus, Appollos (he just stayed for a short while), Olympus, Stephenus, Sheba and myself. That was in 1973. (See photo-top-left) Our first open door was in GGA, where the Jesuits lat wa have the use of a bungalow in a mission compound. Here we ministered to the hippies - with evening campfires and free food, and the Lord blessed us with quite a few disciples.

Quring the next 3-6 months, shout 30 family came from froglend. We sli got united and inspired with the vision for INDIA - Halislujah! The work in the Compound lasted about a year. Gos gets very hot and tourists are only there during certain sessons. So we eventually closed up, and from there, we brenched out to Bombay, New Delhi and Panjia (a city in Gos.)

Se that was 1974. We mainly litnessed and ministered to the hippies. We got some support from WS, but mainly we got support by going to the Hotels and "PRR" Witnessing to the tourists, talling them our ministry to the hippies. In those days, we were not doing much with the Nationals.

AN ANGEL - AND A T.V. APPEARANCE

Olympus, Stephanus, Lydis and I went to pioneer Delhi, but at a month there, our views ran out and us went to Bangla Desh

a renewal.

We only had one-way tickets!! Well, it was the Lord sending us and we certainly did not lack anything, as He raised up an absolute angel who fed us and paid our hotel bill for a whole week. (Ha didn't even speak English!) But the minute we met a Church dentact that supplied all our needs, we never mat the first man again - a real angel! ITL!

The Lord really opened doors there and we were on Ty for 15 minutes. It was the first time any kind of Christians had sung on Ty in Bangia Desh because it's muslim! Then we had a front-page, favourable article in the Newspapers - as the you-know-who! Plus we met a real king who bought our plane tickets back. Typ: ME 6:33;

VISAS - GOD'S INSTRUMENT

Us flew back to Delhi. We could only get one month's visa! But it was through these visa "problems" that the Lord pushed us out to pioneer the surrounding countries. We never even thought of Nappal, Bangla Desh, etc...our hearts were so much into India; But through these vise situations, the Lord eccomplished His

purpose.

So we went to Nepal. The Lord dealt with us there because of our low stendard of Hygiene and really becoming one in the wrong ways, (plue other spiritual lessons). We got very ill and I simost died! "Most of God's merciful judgements...turn out to be blessings of chastisement to purge and purify His Children and bring a change for the better!" (203:45)

LIT, LIT, LIT!

ratly 1975. Olympus and I went back to Deihi and opened a Home, with a ministry to the freeks.

We stayed in Delhi for about 9 months and Litnessed like crazy! This was during the "Litnessing Revolution". We would be out on the streets 10-16 hours a day. We had quotes and at that time, esked for donations. It was English Lit but we gave it out to the Nationals. Thank God for the hungry multitudes!

After that, I went to Bombay, and again, litnessed and litnessed. By then we had a few National disciples. Gradually, acre brothers came from the west. The Homefwere of quite a good atanderd.

9 months later I went hack to Delhi and the second atanderd.

9 months later I went back to Delhi and there we started a poorboy Club. We only did it for a few months and closed down because it didn't bear the right fruits as the wrong kind of people came.

AMRITSAR AND BENARES OPENED

Later on, Shedrach and I want to pioneer Amritsar (near the border with Pakistan). We ministered to the freeks and started that the started with the started with the started with the started with for a few months and the children became family we stayed with for a few months and the children became from there, I went with Auranam to pioneer General (also called Veranasi) - which is the religious capital of the Hindus (like their Jerusalem). The River Genges flows through it. The Hindus count it a real blessing to die there, so many dying pilgrims make their way to this city. All that to say this; it is a very demonic piece.

Verstayed about three months and the Lord gave we show disciple there. We litnessed a lot to the locals and witnessed to the freeks, plus "P.R. witnessing" to the foreigners in the hotels.
