THE PAST MONTH HAS BEEN A TREMENDOUS MONTH for all of us here. So many newspapers are interested in the Daily Might that it has now turned into a major job just sending materials and replying to the readers letters. Charity has now joined us to help and has been a tremendous blessing in helping to raise support and to also act as our pretty salesgirl. GBH. We started the month by sending letters to every newspaper in this country that we could find the address of. In all it was over 100. We as well sent letters to English language newspapers in 11 Asian countries.

PROBABLY THE MOST ENCOURAGING THING IS TO SEE JUST WHAT AN EFFECT IT IS HAVING on the country as so many are reading. We have personally met or heard from 20 people who regularly cut out the column and are making a collection.

EVEN IN REMOTE CORNERS OF THE COUNTRY THE DAILY MIGHT IS NOW WELL KNOWN as we found recently when on a road team. We spent one week visiting all the smaller newspapers in 4 provinces. Some of these we had written to and others which we did not have the address of. The result was just fantastic. Some had even started to run the sample material that we sent in our introductory letter to them.

WE HAD 7 PUBLICATIONS ACCEPT MATERIAL for immediate publication and another 6 said they will soon start. Although many of these are small they help to saturate their area with the message. In one city all 3 newspapers want to run it and we will provide each with different material.

WE HAVE FINISHED PUTTING TOGETHER A MONTHLY DM BOOKLET to send to all that write in, and it is also useful for DTD, fish food, etc. It starts with some pages on salvation and the Holy Spirit and works through to end off with some

3) And already the Lord is answering! We received a note at Christmas from a 19 yr old sailor in the US Navy. We met him in the Philippines one night when he had been drinking. He told us how he was backslidden from the Lord & asked us to write to him. So I did & he answered with a little note & two dollars. Then we sent him our Christmas prayer letter & he answered right away with \$40 & a short note. GBH!

4) Another friend in the Philippines answered us whom we had not seen or heard from for a year, & he replied, "your letter help us with your prayers & does not only surprise me, but shock me indeed! It proves you still remember a friend far

WE ALSO WROTE LETTERS TO MANY BUSINESSES RAISING SUPPORT for our work and have had some very good donations. They are happy to give to something that they can clearly see having such effect.

IN ALL WE SENT OUT ALMOST 400 LETTERS for the moth. A lot of typing went into it but it was so much fun and has united us so much as we all share the load, the goal and the many victories. If you are able to help us then please send a donation. It will be a lot to reach millions each month
