## **Buddha Light Association Sees the Light**

While visiting a doctor we bumped into a Buddhist nun who we had met some time ago at a show we did at the large temple in downtown Kaohsiung that she is head of. As soon as she saw us she got all excited and invited us to perform over the Chinese New Year at the largest center for Buddhism in Southern Taiwan, and headquarters of the international Buddha Light Association. The occasion was a large flower show that is held there every year. and that attracts hundreds of thousands of people over the New Year holidays.

Needless to say we prayed about whether we should accept this invitation, and the Lord encouraged us to let His light shine, and that He had sheep everywhere. While we waited for our turn, some traditional Chinese dances were performed, which didn't excite people very much. Before the kids marched onto stage,

Mercy encouraged them to call on the keys, to smile big, and to ask the Lord to change the whole spirit of the place through their songs and dances. And the Lord did just that! The oppressive religious spirit was lifted and people started clapping and shouting, especially when the children sang some popular folk songs in Chinese and the local Taiwanese dialect. During the show we noticed one monk with a fancy digital camera taking tons of pictures. After the show he introduced himself to us as a reporter for the Merit Times, which is the largest Buddhist newspaper in Taiwan. A few days later this newspaper carried a nice picture of our children's show with the caption reading, "On the fifth day of the New Year, the Shi family from Austria came to perform Austrian and Taiwanese dances and

songs at Foguangshan. Mr. Shi and his family are part of The Family International Christian Fellowship." The circulation of this newspaper is about 300,000 in Taiwan, plus overseas editions in the USA and Australia.

Later the reporter monk sent us the photos he had taken by e-mail and had this to say: "Thank you for coming to the mountain to do such a beautiful show for us. You brought the people faith and hope. These gifts are expressed in each of your songs and dances. You have given people faith, joy and hope for this coming year. What a light you have! We truly appreciate that light!"

receiving it. In fact, they like us better, and like Jesus' liberal and forgiving love.

A new way of provisioning

Michael, Romania: Now, when we provision, instead of presenting our work with the emphasis on our CTP/ humanitarian ministries, we present ourselves in the most simple and to the point way: "We are the Family (which is a church/free Christians/fellowship of believers)," and we go immediately on the attack talking about Jesus and our evangelistic ministries. We witness to them about the many lives helped and changed from alcoholism, drugs, violence, etc., by our giving them the Gospel.

We have seen that comparatively, people respect us and our work even more this way. This helps us to get to the point quicker in witnessing to them about the Lord, being able to use the Word more and on the spot and see potential for future follow-up—all because we approach them as 100% missionaries for Jesus, and not as "humanitarian/social worker missionaries." It is, by far, way more powerful in the spirit! It works!

Christine, USA: God on God is a great conversation starter and helps to get people asking questions about the Bible and exposes people to our more radical beliefs right off. We gave it to one girl, and she called to ask guestions which led us to be able to witness more deeply to her. She has since been coming over regularly and is really spiritually hungry. She told us that when she had first started reading this she had asked herself, "Wait a minute, is this supposed to be real or what?" And the answer came to her, "It doesn't matter, it's good stuff!"

#### **Downsides to "Family** capitalism"

Male, Africa: A lot of things changed since the Charter, a lot for the good, but quite a few new bad traits came out, which we didn't suffer from so much before as things were more regulated and treated quicker by more shepherding in our former structures. I thought we could compare it to the fall of communism, ha! In a way we were like a communistic society before the Charter. where things were more enforced through strong shepherding, but since the fall of that "wall," people have more freedom, but also the negative traits of capitalism set in-more selfishness, less fear to disobey, etc.

One thing that I'm struggling with is how to help people see more clearly the negative consequences their actions have in their own lives. I'm aware that that's exactly what Mama and Peter are trying to accomplish in all the beautiful new GNs. It works, but it's amazing to me to see how difficult it seems for some people to let more of this counsel into their lives, mainly because we don't have that direct shepherding [from people] which we had before, where people couldn't just read the New Wine and live it according to their own will and "application." If they were off, they were told sooner or later and in no uncertain terms.

After all these years of reading the Word and learning from different samples, I realize that I still don't know how to tell others about things that I think should change in their behavior. I think one reason is that people are

so sensitive, that I don't know how to bring it up. After some time I feel like I'm failing these precious brethren, but I don't know how to help them as when I try to bring something up, they don't want to hear anything contrary to the way they operate.

I think we miss out on a lot of blessings and progress because of a lack of honest and open communication and receptivity. The attitude of "who are you to tell me what to do?—And if you do, I know plenty to tell you back!" seems to be prevalent. I've lived with some people that were basically impossible to talk to and everything had to be their way or they would "throw a fit" or be highly offended. This made me and others in the Home stop bringing things up to them and eventually leaving the Home. Sometimes those people end up on their own or going FM, not being able to live with others. Most of the time it's not so bad, but you feel like you would like to get more across, but can't, because you realize there is just too much opposition and too little vacuum.

#### Caring for our absent children

A woman, Earth: We are blessed with a unique and wonderful understanding of caring for and being involved in one another's children's care, as we raise and nurture them in Christian graces and service for the Lord. What may be quite obvious to some, but not to others, is the point of communication with our absent children. In this case I am referring to any whom we know we should be communicating

#### PASSION OF THE CHRIST, THE (2004) James Caviezel, Monica Bellucci, Maia

Morgenstern

Intense drama detailing the 12 hours of Jesus' life, from the Garden of Gethsemane to His crucifixion. The movie is powerful, realistic, and guite Scripturally accurate, but may be too graphic for some to watch. (The majority of the two hours, while very meaningful, is very violent and painful.)

(Jesus:) The Passion of the Christ, while disturbing, will help you be touched by the immensity of My sacrifice for you. Never before has the torture and extreme suffering that I experienced been so graphically portrayed, and it's bound to have an effect on virtually anyone who sees it.

So many of My children take communion without truly understanding what it means. Every time you break bread, I want you to remember that My body was indeed crushed and broken for you. When you drink the wine, I want you to remember the full extent of what it cost Me to shed My blood for you. For I knew that I would have to suffer these things, and that it would be nearly unbearable physically. But My love for you was great—much greater even than the pain.

This movie is not for everyone. It should not be shown to anyone JETT age or younger, without it first being previewed by their parents or the responsible adults. Also, if you're someone who is easily affected by violence and gore, and if you already have a deep understanding and appreciation for the great sacrifice I made for you, the movie may disturb you more than it's worth. It's important that you ask Me if this movie is for you.

If I confirm that you should watch it, do not go into it expecting to be inspired. The message as a whole will feed you spiritually and sober your spirit. However, you will most likely not go away with images of My smiling face, but rather, images of My love and mercy, depicted on My blood-drenched, pain-ridden face. The Passion of the Christ is about understanding just how far I was willing to go because of My love for you.

(Jesus:) This isn't a "feel good" movie. It was meant to be an experience—a virtual journey of sights and sounds that would burn themselves into your mem-

ory so indelibly that you'd never be able to forget them. The extreme violence in the movie was designed to take you to the edge, almost to the point where you can't take it any more. That was the intent and what the producers were hoping for.

You might not necessarily be touched or moved by this the way you'd expect. It's not "inspiring," and you're not going to come away feeling emotionally, or even spiritually "high." For most, the graphic violence will be too much, too overwhelming for that. But afterward, when meditating and praying about it, you'll probably find that you were affected in even a much deeper way than what you had expected, a more important and lasting way.

There are, of course, lots of other parts, other chapters of My life that you're familiar with, which could have been depicted as well. I'm your Friend, your Shepherd, your Lover and Husband, your Miracle Worker, and the One Who rose from the dead. And it would be nice if other movies would be made about My life, depicting these other sides of Me in just as powerful and graphic terms. But the fact is, if I hadn't been willing to go through those horrendous twelve hours of torture and crucifixion, none of the rest would really mean anything anyway. It would have been nice and sweet and comforting and made people feel good, but it wouldn't have been enough. It wouldn't have really mattered or made a difference. In order to truly put skin on it all, I had to go through the torture and horror of the cross.

There could have been a different emphasis in this movie. It could have been less graphic, less torturous. But this is the movie I wanted for this time, for this generation, and I gifted and anointed these men to make it. Of course it's not perfect. No production or witnessing tool is or will be. But this is the movie I knew would generate the kind of controversy that would get the attention I wanted to get. Most people today, especially the younger generation, have to have something harsh, violent, horrible, and graphic in order to get their attention.

It's true that his conservative Catholic background strongly influenced Mel Gibson in his decision to emphasize the cross and the suffering to such an extent. It's not the whole story by any means—just one brief chapter of My life, twelve short hours. But just because it didn't tell the whole story, or dwell on something more inspiring, doesn't mean that it didn't accomplish what I meant for it to accomplish or cover the material that it needed to cover.

Your religion in the Family is a happy one, and you tend to concentrate more on the freedoms and blessings I've given you, than you do about things like suffering and sin and death on the cross. But if you choose to watch this, if you're able to, it will be good for you. If you ask Me to help you see beyond the suffering, beyond the hardships I endured and understand the great love that saw Me through it, you'll partake of that love and leave uplifted.

If I show you to watch it, and if you call upon Me to be with you as you do, I will help you to be touched by the good and will protect your spirit from being negatively affected. It might hurt momentarily, but the pain will pass, and you will be left with a stronger and much more knowledgeable understanding of how blessed you truly are to be My brides, and what wonderful love we will be able to share together for all eternity.

#### **GIRL WITH A PEARL EARRING (2003)**

Colin Firth, Scarlett Johansson

Drama based on a novel speculating what happened behind the scenes of a famous painting by the Dutch artist Johannes Vermeer.

(Jesus:) This movie is interesting if you are interested in art, or in the way people lived in the mid-1600s in Holland. It's historical fiction. It has some interesting things about art and the acting is well done. It gives a glimpse into life in those times and the difference in the classes. It gives insight into the hand-to-mouth existence that some of these artists lived, how the patronage system worked and the lengths that the artists had to go to in order to realize their dreams. It also shows how life was difficult in those days for the poor and those who had to seek employment as maids and housekeepers, and they worked from morning until night with no thanks and little pay. There is much in the movie that is informative about that time period—down to the details of how they did laundry, how they cooked and prepared meals, how artists ground and mixed colors, etc.

It is a deep and somewhat ponderous film, and you really need to get into it some in order to get something out of it. It's a character study and brings out the very human traits of a desire for love and acceptance, as well as jealousy, insecurity, and the sad results of a lack of good communication. The people in the movie weren't particularly wise, but neither were they malicious or evil. They were just human, and didn't have My love and My light to guide them. In their own way, they were all trying to do the best they could.

Sometimes it takes seeing a movie like this which contrasts so starkly with your life, to help you realize how blessed you really are. It shows how impossible it is to do the right thing without My love and wisdom and insight and strength and unselfishness. Some would find it interesting or would gain good lessons or principles from it. Others would be discouraged or saddened by it, or it could add weight to their battles of insecurity or jealousy or their fears. Ask Me if this movie is one you should watch.

#### **MIRACLE (2004)**

Kurt Russell, Patricia Clarkson Miracle tells the true story of Herb Brooks, the player-turned-coach who led the "underdog" 1980 U.S. Olympic hockey team to victory over the seemingly invincible Russian squad.

(Jesus:) This is a true story of a man who believed in doing the impossible. But his victory didn't come without a lot of hard work, stick-to-itiveness, and bucking the tide. To accomplish what this man had the vision for, he had to break out of the norm, in spite of opposition.

The rewards that he was working towards were earthly; nevertheless, seeing the movie should inspire My children that their labors are not in vain. Even though they don't see a lot of rewards, they should know that their determination to be My disciples, to make personal sacrifices for the sake of their Home and My Family, does not go unnoticed. There are good lessons in this movie, both for "players" (or disciples) and also for "coaches" (shepherds).

It was a miracle to get all those boys together, united, working in teamwork, giving their all. It shows the importance of teamwork, unity, forsaking all, perseverance, putting your all into what you believe in, taking it seriously and really going for it with all you've got. That's what you need to do in the Family! Of course, there's a lot of U.S. hype and patriotism thrown in there, but take that with a grain of salt.

This is a movie with lots of good lessons and incentive for people to be the best they can be. The teamworking lessons are extremely valuable for My children. In the world, teamworking is a good trait, but in My Family it is a vital trait. A house divided cannot stand, so in order for My children to move forward they must be united and work as a team. #### MIRACLE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA, THE (1952)

Gilbert Roland, Susan Whitney
Dramatization based on a true story
of three Portuguese shepherd children
who saw visions of Mary in 1917.

(Jesus:) This movie is a testimony of how I can take the seemingly weak and foolish things of this earth to confound the wise. Poor shepherd children were given this vision from Heaven, which caused so many to believe.

There's a very good message in this movie about holding on to your faith despite the obstacles or the tribulations, and standing strong. This is something that would really encourage kids in the Family—to see what it was like for these three kids to be persecuted. Even though they were scared, they still kept their trust in Me, and weren't afraid of the man who was trying to do them harm, and their simple believing faith won in the end.

This movie will give you a lot to discuss. It should be previewed ahead of time, so you can use it to get some good dialogue going with your children and to address something that is often difficult to discuss. The movie is rather old-fashioned, and therefore the acting is overly dramatic. But on the overall, it's a good portrayal of history, the times

that this event occurred in, and it can give your older children not just a good little history class, but also a class on what to do when facing persecution.

This movie shows that those who fight you are often those of the established religions, your own family, friends, and eventually the rulers of the land. But, My dear little ones, never fear. For if you will remain faithful to Me, great will be your reward and I will be with you always.

Though we don't promote the rituals of the Catholic Church or worship of the Virgin Mary, it can be explained to the kids how I worked according to the faith and belief of the people of this village. This aspect of the movie can also be used to help the children understand more about the beliefs of those who belong to the Catholic faith.

This movie can be shown to MCs as long as the movie is explained to them, as otherwise it would go over their heads. But since it's so wholesome it would be fine for their age group to watch. And the best way to view it is to not just stop at watching the movie, but make it an object lesson and supplement it with My Word.

#### **50 FIRST DATES** (2004)

Adam Sandler, Drew Barrymore (Dad:) This is an entertaining romantic comedy for the most part, but it's sad that they had to throw in the crass or ungodly elements—like the homosexual aspect, one of the men making frequent derogatory digs at his wife, and a few gross scenes or lines sprinkled throughout. It's not that it's altogether bad or unwatchable, but the few not-so-great and not-so-inspiring elements have turned what might have been a very sweet and innocent and fun and enjoyable movie into something a little impure.

No movie is altogether "pure"—but this could have been a pretty pure and innocent movie if it weren't for some of the uncalled for and unwanted aspects of it.
