Read Genesis 6–8 (also *Life with Grandpa 5*, pages 1–64) for the story of how Noah listened to and obeyed God, and saved his family and many animals during the Flood. You can read about Moses's early life in Exodus 2:1–15. Moses later spent 40 years in the wilderness as a shepherd learning lessons God had for him of humility, patience, and following God's lead.
