Praise God from Whom all blessings flow! Thank you so much for your help and prayers! The Lord has truly been blessing! Although temporarily stunned by the loss of Grandmother from our midst, with all her wonderful inspiration, leading and example, it was "better for her to depart, for, as Paul says, "to be absent from the body (so worn) is to be present with the Lord!"

The Lord Himself has comforted and compensated for her absence with some of the greatest blessings and opportunities of service that we have had in high schools, youth groups, teen clubs, business mens meetings, churches, public auditoriums, hippie hangouts, beaches etc.-- wherever the teens are!

Many have been saved and filled with His Spirit, and it's a thrill to see these newly-won youth set on fire and ardently witnessing to others of their new-found faith! Even Christians are revived and put to shame by the hunger, fire and zeal of these newcomers' bold witness!

Danny the hippie, saved on Thursday, filled with the Spirit the next Thursday and fired for witnessing the following Thursday, is now preaching and winning souls like a house afire--which he is: God's house on fire! His friend Christine, a Catholic drug addict, has been testifying and bringing her friends to be saved, and their enthusiasm is a sight to behold!

We asked the Lord for room to take some of these young folk in to teach His Word and train for His Service, as we have done for years, and a refuge with water in time of trouble--the "sudden great confusion" the Lord warned Mother is coming soon. Immediately He showed us a large ranch only two miles north on a ridge right here in Huntington Beach, and the next day miraculously led us to it, wells and all, and gave us the free use of it for months to come!

This "Teens for Christ School" is now filled with young witnesses studying, working and praising the Lord together: Harvey the former Jewish drug addict from New York; Lurana the folksinging college girl from Kansas; Lois the lovely TV singer; Berry the daughter of a famous Bible-quoting evangelist; Russell the country guitarist; Janie and Barbara, highschool students free to serve the Lord for the Summer; Happy the handsome Marine; Paul the sailor, etc.

Our own staff of seasoned veterans, of course, includes "Uncle Dave" the Director; "Aunt Jane" the Manager; Paul the prophet and musician; Jonathan the co-ordinator; Faith the faithful; Arnie the organizer (who's just been drafted--pray for him!); Sara the dietitian and child-care specialist; Artie, chauffeur and mechanic; Claudia our secretary; John and Linda, helpers, with Little Joy, Junior and newborn baby Philip--and more "on the way"!

The Lord has wonderfully answered your prayers for our boys in keeping them in His service, including Paul, who is now III-A ("expectant father"), and Arnie, who has only now been inducted despite his ministry of two full years in the Lord's service, but who has long felt the Lord would eventually call him into the Army as a witness, and this proving to be true.

Space fails us to tell of the many other answers to prayer: the new camper for witnessing trips; preservation of Grandmother's little cottage for counseling, office and headquarters; renting of the house in front for John and Linda and Little ones, helpers in this ministry; and one of the greatest of all: He's beginning to supply the great need for the reprinting of Grandmother's book, "The Hem of His Garment", story of her life that has been such a blessing to so many--soon to go to press again, God willing--thanks to Him and your help & prayers!

We hope to add a chapter about her recent ministry and revelations, so if you'd like to receive a copy now on a donation basis it would help us complete the republication of the book. A little has also come in on the bronze plaque for her grave, which we hope to be both an honor and a testimony to her and His grace, if the Lord makes it possible. His will be done.

We are also storing up some sacks of grain and foods that require no refrigeration for the coming emergency, as the Lord provides, to assist in the survival of His witnesses during the coming "great confusion". For the Lord told us through Grandmother just before she passed away that though now we were only gleaning a few souls here and there, soon we are to assist in a great harvest of the repentant under the rod of His soon-coming judgments on America!

"When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation spoken of by Daniel the prophet stand in the holy place...then shall be great tribulation: But the people that do know their God shall be strong and do exploits, and they that understand among the people shall instruct many...and they shall prophesy 1260 days. And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there 1260 days (3 1/2 years)."
