

looks, whether he is complaining of pain or discomfort, a loss of appetite, the amount of stools & urine, the nature of any cough & whether his breathing seems normal, or is rapid or hindered. Should you feel led to consult a doctor for medical advice, these symptoms, along with the child's temperature reading, will be of help in his diagnosis.

13. JUST AS DAD HAS SAID BEFORE, "There's hardly anything worse than seeing a little child suffer", & at times of sickness &/or spiritual attack such as this, we're alive in prayer about why it happened & how to treat it --& also just plain ol' mad at the Devil's dirty work".

14. I HAD PERSONALLY NEVER HAD MUCH EXPERIENCE with nursing a fever, though I did know that Dad does not favour bringing down a fever by unnatural means, unless the fever remains or returns to a dangerously high level, which could then be safely reduced with aspirin. In this case, David's fever did NOT remain high, but rather came to a peak a few times, & it never occurred to me then to take his temperature.

15. THE LORD WAS FAITHFUL TO SHOW DAD THE SPIRITUAL CAUSE of this illness so we then felt strengthened & more "aware of the Devil's devices", & were all on the attack against it! ("fighting the good fight of faith": (1Tim.6:12.)

16. "FAITH COMETH BY HEARING THE WORD OF GOD" (Ro.10:7), so I decided we'd have as much Bible as David could possibly take! First he had a private puppet show of Spanish songs & verse review. Then while he still lay in bed, I shared with him a long flannelgraph lesson using various characters I had gleaned from several Bible stories.

17. FIRST I MADE UP A STORY ABOUT A BOY NAMED PETER who did not know Jesus but loved God's creation all around him, so believed in God, but didn't really know if God loved him. He visited a Church of Love meeting in a Family of Love Home & there Peter received Jesus after having a Bible study with the children. This little testimony story included lessons on the salvation, Jesus' crucifixion, the resurrection, etc., all on flannel-

graph. I then continued the story of how our Family of Love witnesses all around the world--how they provision, litness, use the mails, personal witness & FF.

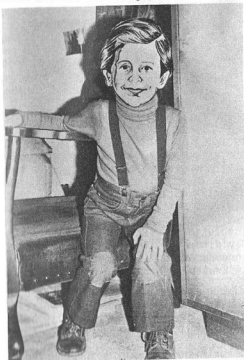

NEXT WE WENT INTO A FF STORY on flannelgraph about one of our Family girls who faithfully witnessed all day long, then went out at night to a club with another sister, & there met a sweet lonely businessman. After dancing & talking together that night, the girl witnessed to him all about her personal testimony, & shared lots of love with him & the man received Jesus: Hallelujah! The flannelgraph lasted about 45 minutes & David listened very intently.

19. THAT NIGHT DAVID SLEPT ALMOST SOUNDLY, at peace & in God's Hands, & once again, the Lord did heal & he was absolutely restored to good health the next day: PTL! His appetite, bowels & disposition were all normal again. We tried to keep him rested & "halfway-calm" so not to over-do that following day, but it was like trying to keep a wild pony in bed! Then, the third day, he was outside at play again, YYY!

ONLY A FEW DAYS LATER, I came down with very painful menstrual cramps, & when David & Alfred laid hands on me to pray, David saw tears in my eyes, so ran to get his Bible & sat right next to me reading his best to comfort & strengthen me--just as I had done for him when he was sick! Such a sweet, faith-ful little soldier -- "...who comforteth (me) in all (my) tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God." (2Cor.1:4.) What a sweet little guy!
