MOMMY IS ALSO VERY VERY FAITHFUL ABOUT TAKING NOTE OF DETAILS & pointing out what things can be improved or offering tremendously helpful suggestions & tips in the children's training very regularly. She noticed that David needed a board under his bed mattress because it was sinking a bit in the middle. "Because his body is still forming, we should be more careful about the posture & position of his body in his bedding, much more so than of our own. He also shouldn't be using such a big pillow, but a very small one, if any pillow at all", she said.

19. MOMMY REMINDED ME, "IT'S ALWAYS HELPER TO HAVE A LITTLE POTTY ON HAND, they're very cheap to buy & really helpful for late-night potty runs. There's no sense in thinking that a little potty is ever too babyish for any age child to use. We even use a plastic covered potty-jar ourselves, especially if our room is too far from the bathroom to make a late-night bathroom run." So we've always kept a child's potty on hand for the children's use at nighttime, & switched later to using a large plastic covered canister like Daddy does for David's use on travels & nighttime.

20. DADDY ALSO LAID DOWN A COUPLE OF NEW HOUSE RULES, such as no more street shoes

in the house, but either barefoot or soft slippers that would prevent the house getting all sandy from the "beachcombers" coming in. He also restricted the laundry down to one-load-per-person, per week--one for beach use & one for body use, so we'd not have to be doing too much laundry & allow time for more important work! 21. ONE THING WE ALL REMEMBER WELL ABOUT what was the beautiful family meetings WE WERE TOGETHER with Dad & Maria on past days. This was when Dad prayed for & ministered the children with oil, as you

read about in "Prayer for the Children", (see No. 753.) Daddy said then that David was now old enough to learn from his Bible studies & family meetings, & he should be able to sit still during Daddy's talks. If he were in the system, he would have to sit through church, like Daddy did at when he was a boy, usually for hours at a time!

22. DAVID HAD BEEN ACTING QUITE FOULISH OF LATE & immediately after prayer & fellowship, he had two falls--once when

swinging between two armchairs & another time when he slipped & fell to the floor. Daddy said, "The Lord is dealing with him about being foolish, & besides, the Devil was mad because we had just had prayer for his healing!"

23. DADDY COMMENTED TO US LATER, "EXPLAIN TO DAVID THAT ONE REASON WHY HE MUST SIT STILL IS BECAUSE THE LORD EXPECTS MORE FROM HIM than any little normal, silly child. That's why he has to learn some of the lessons that he does & the Lord deals with him like that, like he did about his falls."
