

8. YOU MAY REFER TO THESE FAMILY PUBS. BIBLE KNOWLEDGE ACTIVITIES

9. A. YOU MAY MARK THE OLD TESTAMENT SEPARATE FROM THE NEW TESTAMENT while holding the Bible up on its back spine.



How to mark your Bible.

At the very beginning of the New Testament pages which you are holding in your right hand, mark several horizontal lines with a dark colour pen like blue or black. These lines show the child at a division between the Old & New Testaments & will greatly aid his learning to find Bible verses by references! Review daily how verses are looked up. --By Testament, chapters & verse numbers. --This especially important study is actually very easy with day to day practice. (5 yr. old David took 6 months to learn how!) Try to make a game of these more "tedious"

10. B. LEARN THE "BOOKS OF THE BIBLE SONG" FROM FAITHY'S "HEAVENLY SUNSHINE" TAPE BY MMM. Review this song as often as you look up verses together. Always help the child by going very slow & reassuringly to find the verses he is memorizing or researching for Bible study daily.

11. C. MARK IN THE TABLE OF CONTENTS IN THE BIBLE (preferably the children's own Bible with large print), the different sections of the Old & New Testaments. Use fine-point coloured ink pens for marking the sections & other emphasised verses in your Bible: i.e. blue for underlinings, red for Words of Jesus, chapter headings, or to circle numbers of key verses, & green for Messianic Prophecies. A giant-print Bible is a special, helpful blessing for all of your Bible research activities & projects.

12. D. THE BIBLE WAS ORIGINALLY WRITTEN ON LARGE SCROLLS OR ROLLS OF PARCHMENT OF

Why we use the King James Bible, of 1611 AD: ① the most spiritual translation, ② most widespread, familiar ③ time tested = it works!
