Daniel was in Babylon from the first year of the king's Captivity until two years after their return from Captivity. He was God's witness in the palace of the Empire that ruled the World with God's help and anointing. Hallelujah!

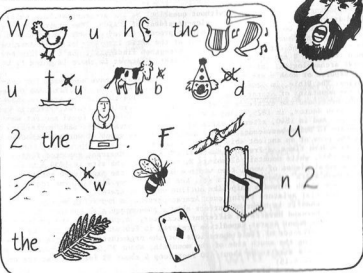
Three brave men!
