

The REVOLUTIONARY RULES!

To become a revolutionary (*completely changed*) disciple (*follower*) for Jesus you must study and learn our basic beliefs and rules prayerfully, and accept them and promise to obey them before you join.

This is a hard life and not for everybody! We are an army -- the Lord's army! And God's a tough commanding officer when it comes to obedience in His army, where nothing is more important than His war against death to save lives!

We are not only an army, but



we are training the officers of the army. We're the toughest officers' training school there is! We're not looking for just any kind of disciples. We're looking for the right kind who are going to be good fighters and good officers (*leaders*).

God's first test for every disciple is to see if you love Him enough to put Him first by forsaking all (*give up everything*) immediately to follow Him. If God is worth serving at all, He's worth serving full-time and all the way! God's only time is now, or forget it! Instant love or nothing!

To be a part of this Family you must keep the rules! Nearly everything in the Revolutionary Rules is based on Scripture!

THE REVOLUTIONARY RULES:

You must:

1. BE SAVED, "born again", "a new creature" by receiving Jesus in your heart! (Jn. 3:3-8; 2 Cor. 5:17)
2. BE FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT! (Luke 11:10-13)
3. WITNESS and tell others about Jesus. (Ro. 10:9, 10; Mark 16:15) Be always ready to witness. "Preach the Word, be instant, in season, out of season" (2 Tim. 4:2). Always "ready to give an answer to him that asketh thee." (1 Pet. 3:15)
4. FORSAKE ALL immediately and follow Jesus. "Sell all that thou hast and follow Me." (Mt. 19:21) "Whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be My



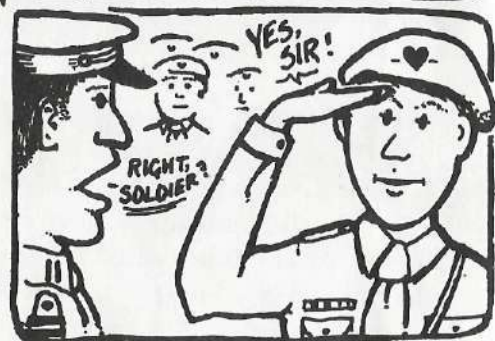
disciple." (Luke 14:33) You will voluntarily (*willingly*) and gladly give all your worldly possessions (*things you own*) to your local Home for sharing with your brothers and sisters according to Acts 2:44 & 45; and 4:32-35. You will withhold nothing from the Lord, and will give them "as unto the Lord". (Eph. 6:6-7) Remember Ananias and Sapphira in Acts 5! Even your life will no longer be your own, but belong to Jesus. (1 Cor. 6:19-20)

5. Be willing to "ENDURE HARDNESS as a good soldier" (2 Tim. 2:3), gladly suffer

affliction & persecution, "All who live Godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution," (2 Tim 3:12) and "rejoice, for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you" (Mt. 5:12). "Having food and clothing, you must therewith be content, (I Tim. 6:8) eating what is set before you giving thanks." (I Cor. 10:27)



6. HAVE NO DEBTS (*money or something owed*), or legal or family obligations (*duties*). "Owe (*have a duty to pay*) no man anything, save to love him." (Rom. 13:8)

7. BE HEALTHY. The weak and handicapped (*disabled or crippled*) may find this life too difficult. If your handicap does not interfere in any way with your service and work duties and witnessing, then fine!

8. "OBEY them that have the rule over you, for they care for your soul, as they that must themselves give account" (*answer for*) (Heb. 13:17) Obey quickly and without question your officers in the Lord.

9. OBEY THE LAW and officers of the law, owners of property, (*landlords*) officials, and so on. "Agree with thine adversary (*enemy*) whilst thou are in the way with him." (Mt. 5:25)

10. DO ALL DUTIES (studying, witnessing, sharing, prayer, etc.) faithfully, and "with all

thy might" (Ecc. 9:10), "as unto the Lord and not unto man" (Eph. 6:6-7), "all to the glory of God" (I Cor. 10:31) for "they that shall not work shall not eat". (2 Ths. 3:10)

11. ATTEND ALL CLASSES AND MEETINGS, go witnessing, study, and do all duties, unless excused by permission of the

officer in charge or in an emergency. Absence without leave will not be permitted.

12. GO TWO BY TWO for safety and security. (Ecc.4:9-12)

13. STUDY THE WORD "to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of truth." (2 Tim.2:15) The Mo Letters are the Word of God for today.

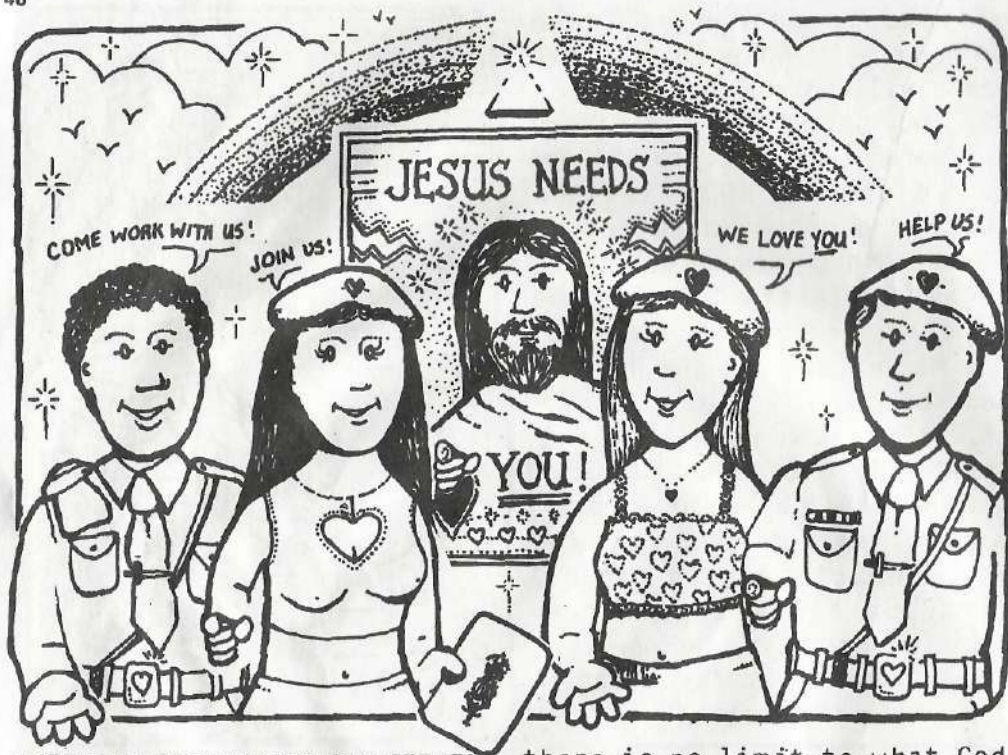
14. KEEP YOUR QUARTERS (*room*) CLEAN AND TIDY AND YOURSELF CLEAN. Be a good clean-looking, well-dressed missionary. Absolutely no sloppy, dirty or hippy appearance. Dress moderately: (*ordinarily*) clean fresh casual clothing is generally acceptable.



15. NO SMOKING! -- "Defile (*spoil*) not the temple of the Holy Ghost". (I Cor. 3:17)

16. BE QUIET AND ORDERLY, cheerful, willing and faithful, as well as diligent, respectful, sacrificial and loving! All must memorise and practise I Cor. 13! "The greatest of these is love!" (I Cor. 13:13)

17. BECOME ONE with the people on the field in which you live. "To the Jew as a Jew, the Greek as a Greek... be all things to all men that you might win some" (I Cor. 9:20). Speak their language, dress as they do, and learn their customs. (*ways*)



These are the rules and beliefs of the Revolution for Jesus. If you still want to serve Him, you can come with us, work with us, join us, live with us or help us. We love you and want to help you live a life of love for Him and others.

If you're willing to be what God wants you to be, then He can mightily use you. In fact,
