SCHOOL: We are having to grow & change & take regular accounts of the situations with the children going to school.

Even the school is difficult for ason, he is very inspired about because it is a challenge for him & eagerly works on his homework in the evenings. I homework is all in Spanish & homework is all in Spanish & takes a lot longer but he has so-much love for his young attrac-tive teacher that he really wants to please her. He was so con-cerned that she receive Jesus & is now so happy that he was able to pray with her.

at home or even keep them hom some days for a good period of school in English. The teachers don't seem to mind. WE ARE ALSO TRYING TO MAKE SURE THE CHILDREN

MAKE SURE THE CHILDREN HAVE GOOD DEVOTION & MEMORY TIME EACH DAY. We really tried having devotions in the morning before school, but it was always so rushed what with having to get all the children up & dressed & fed. So now we have found it much better to have devotions with the children at lunch-time, as the schools here let out for lunch for 2 hours. In the morning we just share a verse & pray togethjust share a verse & pray together before the children leave.

AT FIRST WE WONDERED HOW WE COULD DO OUR WITNESSING & PR work with the little kids, but that's who the little kids, but thet's who we have to work with & now Stephen, age 3, is my regular partner when going to town. He really does a good job & he seems to have more patience for it than the older children. WE'VE SEEN SUCH A CHANGE IN THE LIVES OF THE YOUNGER ONES since the older 3 are poing to school.

JASON IS NOW 8 YEARS OLD & it is so amazing to see how he seems so grown up in so many ways. We're just beginning to realise the importance of the 1st years. Jason is going thru'

the same trials & attitudes that the same trials a attitudes that I had as a <u>teenager</u>! He is really already a little man & there real ly isn't a lot we can change now So many times it is just up to the Lord to use the training we have already given him. We're just seeing how quickly children come to maturity & how very little time we really have with

them!

SPENDING TIME WITH

EACH CHILD: One thing that's meant a lot to all of us is to do special favours for one child at a time by letting them come to our room for a special time of fellowship after the others are in bed. Everyone gets his turn & it just happens naturally accordit just happens naturally accord-ing to who really needs some ex-tra time & attention. We have a little snack & time to talk & lave asset other.

IT SHOWS THE CHILDREN WE REALLY CARE ABOUT THEM to include them in our quiet times in the evening some times. The Lord showed us that we need to be more loving & af-fectionate with the children & not only care for their physical & spiritual needs in a systematic way, but rather more lovingly. We're learning that the Lord always makes a way for us to the children what they need we just have the desire to do so & desperate, prayerful hearts for our situation

BEING THRIFTY: After a w weeks of being very low on funds, we learned some very important lessons. We know that as we learn these lessons then the Lord can trust us with more. So many little things saving the water from the cooked vegetables, saving the milk the kids don't drink for cooking, that we don't really need that extra glass of wine or a large scoop of margarine or ho-ney, that half a spoon of coffee

WE ALSO MADE PATCH-

WORK SKIRTS with patch work straps for the 3 girls for singing at Christmas. They are really prettier than anything we could have afforded. The mater ial came from salvaging a large bag of remnants that a neighbour was about to throw away. There was enough for the girls to make hotpads as Christmas



WE KEEP THE CHILDREN'S GOOD CLOTHES SEPARATE from everyday play clothes, the children know that they need to change immediately when returning home. When travelling we keep good clothes in a separate suitcase, & here at home I keep them on a shelf in my room. Their play clothes are very ordinary but whenever we leave the house for anything or expect visitors, all the chil-

or expect visitors, all the chil-dren change into good clothes. WHEN CLEANING HOUSE every morning we always clean up the front room first, as neigh bours might drop by early or a visitor. We try to keep that room neat, clean & free of chil-dren's toys & keep fresh fruit or some flowers there if we or some flowers there if we

or some name have them.

WE HAVE GOOD GEOGRAPHY STUDIES with the children using the Family News. One

week we had a good study of Thailand from 2 testimonies in that edition. We look at the map to see where the country is in relation to the rest of the world, then make a localised world, then make a localised map of that country & countries surrounding it. The children colour the countries different colours & write in their names & those of the major cities etc. We talk about the geography of that country, climate stc. & about current events if we know anything about what's happening there. Then we also remember to pray for the missionaries we just read about there. This helps us to reme ber an important aspect of prayer—to pray for others!

IT'S NOT EASY TO BE PAR-ENTS & takes a lot of sacrifice but this becomes just a normal part of our lives if we learn to surrender our own will, lay our all on the alter & start to just live thru' our children. I know Secundus & I sometimes just really need to get down & pray together & ask the Lord to give us a renewed fresh love for each other when our relationship becomes somewhat strained. I think this can happen with all

the pressures & responsibilities of raising a family.

BUT WE JUST KNOW IT'S THE LORD'S WILL for us to be together & love each other. So we just have to ask the Lord to give us the love we need, & He always does. After a good pray er session like that we always have a good love session afterward & are really thankful for each other & have a renewed & more mature love. We always need to pray, too, that the Lord give us the burden, vision & love we need in caring for our children, just because we know that it is the Lord's will & we don't want to fail them or cause them to fail the Lord.
