GEOGRAPHIC SPELLING BEE HOW MANY NAMES OF CIT-IES CAN YOU SPELL? In this game the 1st player spells the name of a city, then the next player has to spell the name o a city beginning with the last letter of the one just spelled. IF THE IST PLAYER

SPELLS PARIS, the 2nd player must spell the name of a city be ginning with an "S". The play-er who can't think of a city when it's his turn must drop out



SHOPPING HERE'S A CHANCE TO TEST YOUR MEMORY. The 1st player says, "I went to the grocery store today & I bought some oranges." The 2nd player repeats exactly what the 1st player said & adds another item. THE 3RD PLAYER REPEATS WHAT THE 1ST 2 PLAYERS SAID & adds another item, & so on. If you forget an item, TEST YOUR MEMORY.

GO TOGETHERS TEST YOUR THINKING A-BILITY in naming the direct op-posite of the word called by the other person, or the word that's usually associated with the oth-
