CAT IN THE WINDOW!

ANIMALS COUNT IN THIS GAME. Some count only a few points & others a great deal. Here's how the game goes:

TWO PERSONS PLAY, with each player counting animals on his side of the road. Set a time limit for the game. The player with the highest score wins.

MOST ANIMALS COUNT 10 POINTS. You are in luck if you see a cat in a window. It counts 100 points; so does a white horse or a donkey.

STORY TELLER

THIS ONE'S FUN because you don't know where it will lead! Pick someone to start telling a story—one he knows or one he makes up on the spot. Then when he reaches a place in the story where something strange or exciting is about to happen he calls "HALT!"

AT THAT POINT, THE NEXT PERSON picks up the story & continues it. When he reaches an exciting place he calls "Halt!" & so forth.



ALPHABET DERBY

AS YOU DRIVE ALONG THE ROAD, LOOK FOR SIGNS & WORDS along the highway.

When you see a word that begins with A, say it aloud. Then the person next to you tries to find a word that begins with B, then C, D & so on thru' the alphabet.

SEE HOW LONG IT TAKES you to go all the way to Z. The words must be in alphabetical order. You'll have to look hard for the letters Q, X & Z! (Ed.: Try thinking of *Biblical names & places beginning with A,B,C etc.!*) (Or songs & verses!—Dad)



GEOGRAPHIC SPELLING BEE

HOW MANY NAMES OF CITIES CAN YOU SPELL? In this game the 1st player spells the name of a city, then the next player has to spell the name of a city beginning with the last letter of the one just spelled.

IF THE 1ST PLAYER SPELLS PARIS, the 2nd player must spell the name of a city beginning with an "S". The player who can't think of a city when it's his turn must drop out of the game.



SHOPPING

HERE'S A CHANCE TO TEST YOUR MEMORY. The 1st player says, "I went to the grocery store today & I bought some oranges." The 2nd player repeats exactly what the 1st player said & adds another item.

THE 3RD PLAYER REPEATS WHAT THE 1ST 2 PLAYERS SAID & adds another item, & so on. If you forget an item,

you're out of the game.

GO TOGETHERS

TEST YOUR THINKING ABILITY in naming the direct opposite of the word called by the other person, or the word that's usually associated with the other word.

THERE ARE LOTS OF SUCH WORD COMBINATIONS we use every day—rain/shine, butter/bread, walk/run, summer/winter etc. You have 2 seconds to answer. The player giving the most answers in that time period wins.

FIRST ONE TO SEE

ALL THE PLAYERS IN THIS GAME AGREE upon one subject (it might be a bridge, a color, a barn, a dog etc.) which they are likely to see along the way. The 1st one to see the chosen subject & report it to the others gets 1 point.

IF 2 PLAYERS SEE THE SUBJECT at the same time, it is a tie; & they each get a ½ point. The 1st player to get 10 points for seeing the most objects 1st wins the game. (Play it ABC too!)



SAFETY

EVERY DAY YOU SEE MOTORISTS, PEDESTRIANS & BICYCLISTS conduct themselves in unsafe ways. Their carelessness could be dangerous or harmful to themselves or others. See how observant you can be by conducting your own safety contest.

EACH PERSON LOOKS FOR UNSAFE CONDUCT by others. When an unsafe act is spotted, point it out to Mom & Dad.

Thank the Lord he was so hungry to learn at an early age, for now he is already learning such important spiritual lessons & hungering for the Word, that I am sure in a short time he will be ready for much more mature responsibilities & experiences in life.

MANY OF YOU HAVE ASKED FOR NEWS OF OUR PRESENT SITUATION. I am caring full-time for both David-5 & Davida, our little girl of almost 4, & have been since little Techis was born, when sweet Dora began caring for her. David & Davida are as opposite in character as they are in looks.—Hal! And I am learning so many lessons in trying to teach & train & care for them both, that I can much more easily relate to many
